### Fall Enrollment Overview

The Fall Enrollment component collects student enrollment counts by level of student, enrollment status, gender and age / ethnicity. In addition, first-time students' fall-to-fall retention rates and student-to-faculty ratio are collected. Enrollment by age is divided in odd-numbered years, and enrollment by gender of first-time undegraduates is divided in even-numbered years.

Institutions operating on a traditional academic calendar (semester, trimester, quarter, or 4-1-4) report Fall enrollment as of the institution's official fall reporting date on October 15. Institutions operating on a calendar that differs by program that enrolls students on a continuous basis (from day-to-day or month-to-month) report Fall enrollment as students enroll during the period August 1 and October 31.

### Data reporting reminders:

- Report data to accurately reflect the time period corresponding with the IPEDS survey component, unless such reporting is seemingly inconsistent with policy allowing.
- Part B, Enrollment of students by age, is optional this year.
- Part C, Record of first-time gender certificates, including gendered students, is required this year.

### Changes in reporting:

The following changes were implemented for the 2022-23 data collection period:

- The "Non student alien" terminology has been changed to "U.S. Non student" but should include the same category of students.
- A question about gender has been added after Part A - Fall Enrollment Summary to collect information about students for whom gender does not fit the binary (Men/Women) categories provided. **Institutions should still allocate those students to the Men/Women categories in other screens of the survey 2 component at this time.** New FAQs have been added to help institutions with this reporting.
- Reference to summer term will change to summer session.
- FAQ #8 on consistency reporting of EF, E12, and OM has been updated for clarification.
