The entry fee must be paid at time of registration. Teams will pay the Spring Creek rate (\$8)

GENERAL PROCEDURES

Please use the Captain's Handbook as a resource throughout the year. If you are team captain, please inform your players of all of the guidelines in the handbook BEFORE your first contest.

MEN, WOMEN, & COED DIVISIONS

STARTING THE MATCH

1. **MATCH TIME:** Teams must schedule their own tee times and are responsible for getting their complete round in.
2. **SPRING CREEK GOLF COURSE:** All matches will be played at Spring Creek Golf Course just outside of Whitewater. The address is posted in the league description on IMLeagues. Teams are responsible for all travel to and from the course.
3. **INTRAMURAL SPORTS RULES:** All UW-W Intramural Sports Rules/Policies, as stated in the Intramural Sports Captain's Manual, and Spring Creek Rules/Policies must be followed when playing Intramural Golf.

4. INCLEMENT WEATHER: Spring Creek reserves the right to cancel tee times due to inclement weather. In that case, teams are responsible for rescheduling their tee times.

PLAYING THE GAME

5. FORMAT: Players will play a “scramble” format. Players will both play the selected shot.

6. TEAMS: Two players constitute a team and they must both be registered on IMLeagues and displayed on the team roster. In order to participate in the tournament, teams must sign up before registration closes on IMLeagues.

7. SCORING: Standard scoring will be used.

8. WINNING THE TOURNAMENT: Teams will turn in their scorecards to the Spring Creek Clubhouse. Once all scorecards are turned in, they will be sent to the Rec Sports Office and scores will be read to determine the winner. The team with the lowest gross score wins the tournament. In the case of a tie, the team with the lowest score on the hardest hole will win.

9. SELF-OFFICIATED MATCHES: Matches will be self-officiated. Players are to act and rule with honesty during play. Disputes will not be tolerated and can result in immediate disqualification.

10. UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT: Players/nonplayers shall not commit acts of unsportsmanlike conduct. This includes, but is not limited to, arguments with UW-Whitewater Intramural Sports staff, Spring Creek officials, or other tournament players/teams by any player(s). The Intramural Supervisor reserves the right to dismiss teams from the tournament for unsportsmanlike conduct.

11. Other than the above exceptions, the game will be played according to regulation Golf rules.
