GENERAL PROCEDURES

Please use the Captain's Handbook as a resource throughout the year. If you are team captain, please inform your players of all of the guidelines in the handbook BEFORE your first contest.

LEAGUE STRUCTURE:

1. Racquetball is a sport, depending on popularity and registrations, that can have a varying format.
2. Each team or individual must play by the "play by" date listed on the schedule. Failure to do so will result in a forfeit for the participant failing to show up and/or not returning calls.
3. It is the player's responsibility to contact the opponent, find out a time when both can play, and then call the Williams Center Equipment room to reserve a court. The number to the Equipment room is 262.472.1384. If each player does not have racquetball equipment, you must check out equipment from the Equipment Room with your UW-W ID.
4. If the Intramural Sports Office gets a message (via phone or written) that states that a player will be unable to play by the next "play by" date, then the match will be postponed

until those two players contact each other to complete the originally scheduled match. This match must be replayed prior to the next date of scheduled play. Failure to do so will result in a double forfeit. The Intramural Sports Coordinator will rule on the legitimacy of the reason the match must be postponed.

5. If the above process occurs, it is the responsibility of players to call their opponent to reschedule a match.

6. Once you've completed your match, please go to Room 100 in the Williams Center and report the results. This includes the winning player/team, names of players, total scores of each set, and overall winner to either by phone (262.472.1145) or by note in the Rec. Sports Office.

7. The rules are as follows: Regulation racquetball rules are used. Matches consist of 2 out of 3 games. Games are played to 15, win by 2.

8. If the ball goes above the glass on the back wall, the ball is OUT.
