The purpose of this program is to establish and maintain safe work practices that are intended to prevent occupational noise-induced hearing loss for relevant faculty, staff, and students.

In accordance with the <u>University of Wisconsin-Whitewater Hearing Conservation Program</u>, our campus will be supplying faculty, staff, and students within the Music Department and the Audiology Department with hearing protective ear plugs.

The following rules apply to this program:

- 1. The ear plugs must be worn during any and every class that is within the Music Department or the Audiology Department that has a noise level greater than 85 dB.
- 2. If your first pair is lost or damaged, you must pay a replacement fee for a new pair.
