The following information was taken from the Office Supplies spend category:

Cost Saving Opportunities at 50% Reduction:

- Ricoh savings ~27k/Year
- Laserjet savings ~10k/Year
- Midland savings ~28k/Year
- Toner ~\$30k/Year
- Ink Cartridges ~4.5k/Year

Potential Savings Opportunities = \$100,000 Per Year



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Digital Initiative – Next Steps

- **Connect with iCIT for more information.**
 - Can we effectively track printing volume for employees (I.e. Papercut) to create greater accountability and reduce waste?
- **The Great Clean Up.**
 - Facilitate another round of The Great Clean Up. Emphasize rounding up “personal” office printers. Use campus announcement system and advertise to ADAs.

IT Hardware & Software

Areas of interest that we would like to unpack include, but are not limited to:

- 1. Hardware refresh cycles**
- 2. Encouraging laptops** as the preferred machine type (with necessary exceptions)
- 3. Software contracts**
