



LOT 9 - RESERVED

Student Resident Parking Lot



Lot Specific Regulations

- Only Lot 9 Reserved Permit required and allowed from September to May (end of spring semester)
- Summer Parking requires special parking permit
- License Plate Must Be Visible to Drive Lane
- The vehicle must be parked within painted lines
- Cannot park in Restricted, No Parking or Pay-By-Space stalls
- No Visitor, Guest, Staff or Commuter Parking Permits allowed anytime in reserved parking stalls

Standard Regulations:

- Parking is permitted in marked stalls only. Parking over stall marking lines, along the curbs, on sidewalks of parking lots is prohibited.
- Individual stalls marked with a controlling sign are restricted as detailed on the signage
- Your license plate must always be displayed to the drive lane of the parking area. Your vehicle plate is how your parking rights are validated.
- All State of Wisconsin motor vehicle laws apply while on University lands, including chapters controlling the registration of vehicles and their safe operation.
- Storage of vehicles is prohibited.
