## I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to explain the role of UW-Whitewater Police Service in case we are either called to assist with S.M.A.R.T. (Suburban Mutual Assistance Response Team) or call for assistance from S.M.A.R.T.

## II. POLICY

Officers and staff of UW-Whitewater Police Services will treat any call for a S.M.A.R.T. call up like any other mutual aid request and respond with officers if any are available. Officers are expected to follow the protocol set for a S.M.A.R.T. response in the policy attached in Addendum A. Officers responding to a S.M.A.R.T. call are responsible for notifying the On-Call Supervisor if no Supervisor is on duty to allow the supervisor to fill the staff position lost, if needed.
