Transfer Options

- **Completed Associate of Art or Associate of Science degree:** Students who have completed an Associate of Art or Associate of Science degree from Nicolet College will meet the UW-Whitewater Common General Education Requirements (CGER).
- Associate of Applied Science **does not waive** CGER at UW-Whitewater

Application

- Complete the application online: <https://apply.wisconsin.edu>
- Submit the following materials:
 - An official copy of your final high school transcript/GED/HSED
 - Official transcripts from any colleges or universities ever attended

Priority Deadlines:

- Fall: July 1st
- Spring: December 1st

Students are encouraged to apply at least one semester prior to intended start term at UW-Whitewater.

Admission Requirements

- 2.00/4.00 GPA on a minimum of twelve transferable credits, using UWW Repeat Policy.
- Students who do not have twelve transferable credits will be reviewed based on new freshman criteria.
- The maximum number of semester hours applied to degree from a community college is 72.
- Business, Education and [other majors at UWW may have higher GPA requirements](#) for acceptance into the major.

Calculation of Admission GPA

Grades from all transferable coursework will be used. Developmental transferrable coursework in English and Math is included. A repeated course grade will be used but only if the original grade is C- or lower. Please see the [UWW Repeat Policy](#) for more information regarding repeated courses.

World Language Requirement

World language is only required for students pursuing a Bachelor of Arts within the College of Letters and Sciences. Students that have completed at least 1 year of the same world language from Nicolet College have met this requirement. Only college level world language is considered to fulfill this requirement.

Scholarships

Student's application for admission also serves as the scholarship application. Students must be admitted by April 1st to be considered for scholarships for the next fall semester start. Scholarship consideration is based on transfer GPA and credit amounts.

Special Notes

- Some UW-Whitewater colleges have a diversity course requirement as part of their degree requirements. See Guide below for details. Nicolet College courses that satisfy the U.S. Racial/Ethnic Diversity college requirement are identified as DV.

- **CLEP/AP Credit:** Subject exam scores and credit vary by score. Official test results must be sent directly to UWW for credit to be awarded for CLEP or AP.

General Education Information

Students transferring **with** the Associate of Arts or Associate of Sciences Degree:

- CGER are satisfied with completion of an Associate of Arts or Associate of Sciences degree from Nicolet College.

Students transferring **without** the Associate of Arts or Associate of Sciences Degree:

- **Applied Associate degrees do not waive students from general education requirements.**
- Students who do not earn the Associate of Arts or Associate of Sciences degree before transferring will have their coursework evaluated on a course-by-course basis and may need to complete courses at UW-Whitewater if missing categories below
- Some majors require courses that serve as both degree requirements and satisfy CGER, especially in Business and Education majors. Please reach out to UW-Whitewater Transfer Admissions for more information

CORE classes:

- UW-Whitewater CGER requires students to take four of five multi-disciplinary courses: CORE 110; CORE 130; CORE 120 or 140; and CORE 390. Students transferring 15+ credits from Nicolet may satisfy some of the CORE requirements with substitute courses as follows:
 - CORE 130 can be satisfied with an SBS-S or SBS-E course, as appropriate.
 - CORE 110 can be satisfied with an HA-A course, as appropriate.
