Process:

- (a) Develop a proposal in consultation with a discipline based/academic advisor, defining your academic and career objectives and selecting the courses. *(Optional) Meet with IDMM program coordinator to review feasibility of proposal.
- (b) Prepare (type) the Individualized Minor Application Form.
- (c) Attach a current AR. If you are a recent transfer student, provide a copy of transfer credits accepted by the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater.
- (d) Submit the AR, credit transfer agreement and the completed application to your advisor for approval and signature.
- (e) Attach all forms and submit the proposal to the College Office, Center of the Arts, CA2030.

Individually Designed Minor Requirements:

- (a) If more than 15 credits are taken within one department, your proposed minor must be approved by that department as well as by your major department.
- (b) At least twelve credits must be completed after the minor is approved.
- (c) One-half of the credits earned for the minor must be taken within the College of Arts and Communication.
- (d) Any changes in your minor program after approval will require written permission of the Individually Designed Major/Individualized Minor Committee.
- (e) A minimum of 24 credits is required; the majority of the courses chosen should be 300 or 400 level.
