The Musical Theatre Minor for Music Majors is intended for Music majors whose primary instrument is voice. Approved degree programs include: Music-Music Education Choral Emphasis (BM), Music-Vocal Performance Emphasis (BM), and Music – (Voice Majors) (BA). Music majors whose primary instrument is not voice should enroll in the Musical Theatre Minor program.

Students wishing to add the Minor must apply through the Theatre/Dance Department and audition for the appropriate faculty.

Theatre/Dance Practicums are 0.5-2 credits depending on scope of activity (typically 40 hours per .5 unit). THTR 201 is typically assigned to supporting roles in department productions. THTR 301 is typically assigned to leading roles in department productions. DANCE 200 is typically assigned for participation in Dancescapes. THTR 200 is a general practicum generally applied to scenery, lighting, and costume shop experiences. All practicums are repeatable.
