More than 155 years ago, on April 21, 1868,
the state's second normal school opened its doors to the
first class of 48 students and nine faculty members.

A progressive spirit guided the development of the institution as it evolved from a normal school, which trained teachers for one-room schools, to Whitewater State Teachers College (1927), Wisconsin State College-Whitewater (1951), Wisconsin State University-Whitewater (1964) and as a member of the 13 four-year institutions in the University of Wisconsin System (1971), now the Universities of Wisconsin.

Today, UW-Whitewater is a leading comprehensive university serving more than 12,000 full- and part-time students with 61 undergraduate majors, 21 master's degree programs, one doctoral degree and one education specialist degree in the colleges of Arts and Communication, Business and Economics, Education and Professional Studies, Integrated Studies, and Letters and Sciences. The university awards more than 2,650 degrees every year.

Throughout its history, UW-Whitewater has produced graduates who have actively contributed to the growth of the state and nation. Student learning is the paramount focus of the university's programs and services.

The university takes pride in its regional leadership, national presence and global vision. Many of its academic programs are among the best in the country.

STUDENT SPEAKER

SAMUEL BARDALES



Samuel Bardales made a pivotal decision during the pandemic that, as he reflects, was fruitful in ways that surpassed his own imagination.

In 2021, Bardales made the decision to come to the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater after choosing it over another institution near his home in Gurnee, Illinois.

“I just visited the campus and fell in love,” said Bardales, a Warren Township High School graduate, of his first impression of UW-Whitewater. “I liked the environment, the community and the way the students talked about the school. I definitely saw myself living on the campus.”

From the onset, Bardales decided to get involved in a number of different student organizations on campus and, at various points throughout his undergraduate experience, held leadership roles in more than a half-dozen disparate groups.

“This is the kind of place where professors know your name. It’s where people hold doors open for you. It’s a place where you can find a home if you just let yourself experience it. Being here is not just about the degree that you get; it’s also about the person that you’re becoming.”

Early on, he joined the Leadership Involvement Team for Wells Residence Hall, where he took part in putting on programs, experiencing the hands-on importance of using a budget and working with other residence hall officers.

Bardales points to his involvement as a Whitewater Student Government vice president as another foundational experience that helped chart a path for his time on campus. His roles within the organization include senator for the Drumlin District, secretary of the Academic Affairs Committee and a role on the Student Affairs Committee.

Bardales also was involved in Whitewater Cru, where he led and facilitated a Greek Life Bible study, and gave more than 80 hours of community service as a member of the Lambda Chi Alpha fraternity.

He took part in the National Residence Hall Honorary, where he was recognized for outstanding leadership in student government and residence life. He also played a collaborative role within the Residence Housing Association and volunteered with the UWW Empower community service initiative.

Bardales said UW-Whitewater helped him hone in on his ultimate goal of servant leadership, which he views as the bedrock of his personal and professional goals, post-graduation. As a student teacher, he has worked to instill the value of math in his students.

“Teaching is serving your students. I want to see them achieve success. I want them to feel confident in what they do after they graduate from high school.”

Bardales, who is earning a Bachelor of Science in mathematics and a minor in business law, credits the culture of UW-Whitewater campus with providing the groundwork that enabled him to spread his wings — growing personally and professionally and discovering his true calling in life.

“No matter where you start, when you start, you can make something incredible out of your story.” ❖

COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

MARK PERRY



The University of Wisconsin-Whitewater has long loomed large within Mark Perry's life.

The San Francisco resident is the son of Harold Perry, who graduated from UW-Whitewater in 1933 as a four-year letterwinner in both football and men's basketball and was inducted into the Warhawk Athletics Hall of Fame in 1973.

"I know how much Whitewater meant to my dad," Perry said, adding that his father frequently shared stories and anecdotes of his time as a Warhawk. "He had a lot of 'touches' with the university, throughout his life."

Harold went on to have a successful career that included stints in the Federal Bureau of Investigation and a respected career in business. Over the years he was recognized for his accomplishments, including being honored by the UW-Whitewater Alumni Association as a distinguished alumnus.

In 1958, Harold returned to the university as a commencement speaker, giving an address titled "Statesmanship in Education and Business." For Mark Perry, the opportunity to speak to UW-Whitewater graduates is an honor and a way of connecting with his father's legacy on a deeper level.

That legacy included a \$10,000 gift, contributed by his employer as Harold Perry was retiring in 1974, to help create a scholarship fund that became known as the Harold M. Perry and Margaret A. Perry Scholarship Fund. Subsequent gifts have added to this fund; in the last decades, dozens of meaningful scholarships have been given to UW-Whitewater students.

Today, the family's name endures on the university campus in another way: the Harold M. Perry '33 and Margaret A. Perry Endowed Faculty Chair, a \$2 million gift in 2024 that provides resources to a selected UW-Whitewater faculty member or members to address complex issues, develop long-term solutions and positively impact Wisconsin's economy. The first chair to be named is Jenni Petersen, professor of educational foundations.

Mark Perry's life has been spent on the coasts of the U.S. He grew up in New Jersey while Harold was in the FBI and attended college and graduate school in New England. In the late 1960s, he moved to San Francisco.

Perry has since lived in California with his wife, Mauree Jane Perry, focusing on what he described as three separate 14-year careers that were focused on Silicon Valley.

"I started my career in public accounting, and became an audit partner focused on emerging, high-growth companies. I then transitioned into operations, serving in COO, vice chairman and CEO roles. My third career was as a general partner in a large venture capital firm, focused on early-stage technology companies."

He has been retired for more than a decade, but he remains active through various community service ventures, including board positions on the public media station serving the San Francisco Bay area, a conservancy that supports national parks within the region, and a project — now in 37 states — to transform the delivery of contraceptive care for women.

"From a young age, my father instilled within me a number of life lessons, including the importance of education and giving back." ❖

THE MACE

A ceremonial staff called a mace is the official symbol of the university that is carried by a university marshal and signifies that ceremonies such as convocations, dedications and commencements have been officially sanctioned. The mace is a gift of the Class of 1969 in recognition of the academic growth of the university. Designed by Kurt J. Matzdorf of New York, the mace is fashioned entirely of sterling silver, enamels and amethyst and represents the School of Graduate Studies and the four of the university's five colleges: Arts and Communication, Business and Economics, Education and Professional Studies, and Letters and Sciences.

The carrier of the ceremonial mace is the W.P. Roseman Excellence in Teaching Award recipient. The award, presented annually to a UW-Whitewater faculty member for outstanding teaching, was established in the memory of W.P. Roseman, who directed the campus elementary school from 1919 to 1942. An all-university committee determines the recipient, and the award carries a cash prize. ❖

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The cap and gown that faculty and students wear today have a tradition going back to the 12th and 13th centuries, when students and faculty were considered members of the clergy. The bachelor's gown has a closed front and long, pointed sleeves. The master's gown has an open front and extremely long, closed sleeves; the arms protrude through slits at the wrist and the ends of the sleeves are square, with an arc of a circle just above the bottom. The doctor's gown is an open-fronted garment with voluminous bell-shaped sleeves with three black or blue (for philosophy) velvet bars. Gowns are usually black.

The academic hood is edged in colored velvet, which indicates the field in which the degree was earned. The master's hood is three and one-half feet long, with the colors of the edging for degrees granted by UW-Whitewater. The lining of the hood is purple and white, the official academic colors.

Students wearing gold stoles with "Honor" printed on them are graduates of the University Honors Program. Gold cords designate students graduating with Latin honors (cum laude, magna cum laude and summa cum laude). Some students wear sashes reflecting their participation in student organizations. Graduates who studied abroad or who are affiliated with another country may wear satin sashes reflecting the colors of the country's flag. ❖

THE CHANCELLOR'S MEDALLION

The chancellor's medallion signifies the history and aspirations of the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater. Conferral upon the chancellor declares that person's institutional leadership role, investing the solemn rights, responsibilities and privileges attendant with that honor.

The medallion depicts the tower of Old Main, the building that served as the centerpiece of the campus from the university's founding in 1868 until it was lost to fire in 1970. The design of artist Linda Threadgill, an emeritus faculty member of the College of Arts and Communication, the medallion was cast and constructed in sterling silver and gold plate. Teresa Faris, professor of art and design, designed and constructed a chain of the same materials for the medallion in 2016.

A gift of the UW-Whitewater Foundation, the medallion was originally presented to Chancellor James R. Connor in 1987. ❖

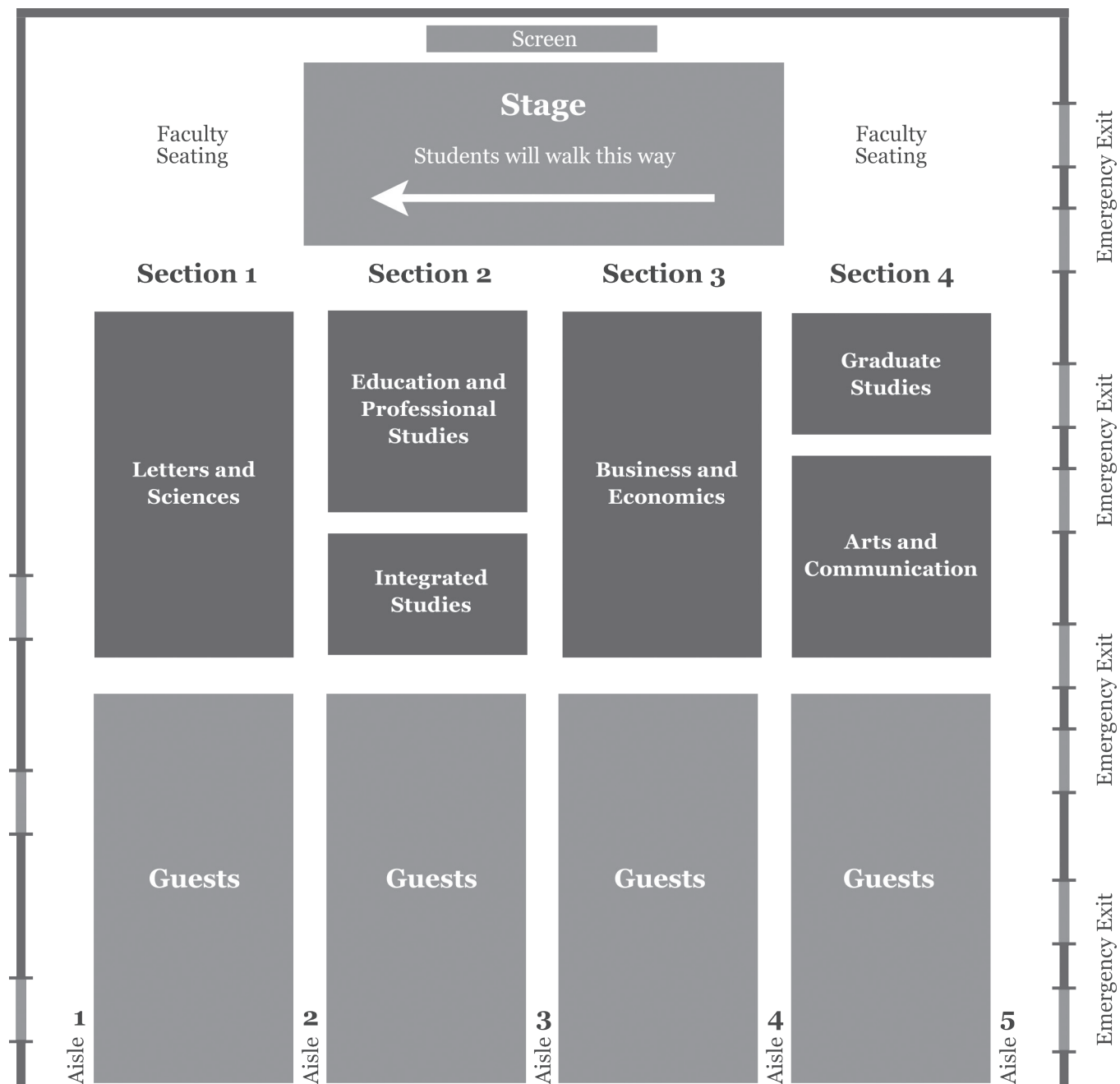

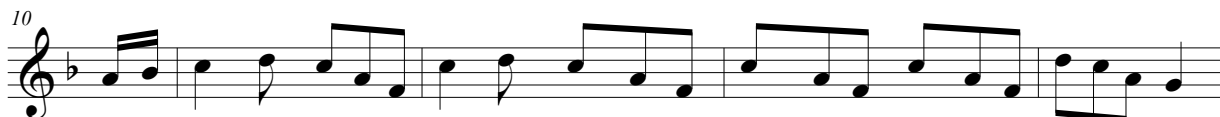
