EDUCATION: GENERAL COURSES (400)

400-740 Techniques Of Assessment And Research -- 3 cr

The course provides practicing teachers with background in two important areas — the course first focuses on helping teachers develop assessments for use in their own classrooms. Helping teachers become better consumers of research information is the goal of the second part of the course.

400-789 Integrative Project Seminar -- 3 cr

This course assists the student in completing the Integrative Project. It should be taken during the semester that the student intends to finish this requirement. The course will be graded on a Satisfactory/No Credit grading scale.

Prereq: Approval of program coordinator and adviser.

400-790 Workshop -- 1-6 cr
