Application Terms and Conditions:

The Honors Program Study Abroad/Travel Study Scholarship is intended to assist University Honors Program students who wish to engage in the high-impact educational practice of studying abroad.


Recipients must meet the following conditions:

- Be in good standing in the University Honors Program (cumulative GPA of 3.4 or higher), and making adequate progress toward completing the program;
- Matriculate full time for a semester or a full year at a university outside of the United States
 OR be enrolled in a travel study course through the University of Wisconsin-Whitewater;
- Earn at least three Honors credits while undertaking the Study Abroad/Travel Study experience. Honors credits may be earned through an Honors travel study course or through an H-Option Project. Students must earn at least a B in an Honors course or in a course in which an H-Option Project is undertaken.

Scholarship Logistics:

Other scholarship terms and conditions are as follows:

- This scholarship is not repeatable.
- Applications will be reviewed by the faculty members of the Honors Council.
- This scholarship application is due by February 20th annually.
- The \$1,000 Honors Program Study Abroad/Travel Study Scholarship will be disbursed in the form of a tuition credit for the semester following the recipient's return to UW-Whitewater.
- A student's class status will be decided from the table below:



Post-Travel Requirements:

- Upon the recipient's return to UW-W, they will submit a four-page report about their experiences. Pages 1-2 should provide a summary of their experiences, page 3 will assess the specific ways in which their travel experiences have enriched them personally, and page 4 will address the larger question of how and why the travel study they undertook connects to their academic and/or career path.
- Additionally, recipients also agree to share about their travel experiences (if requested) with other UW-Whitewater Honors students and/or UW-Whitewater Faculty and Staff. Recipients further agree to allow excerpts from their four-page report to be posted on the University Honors Program website for promotional purposes.
