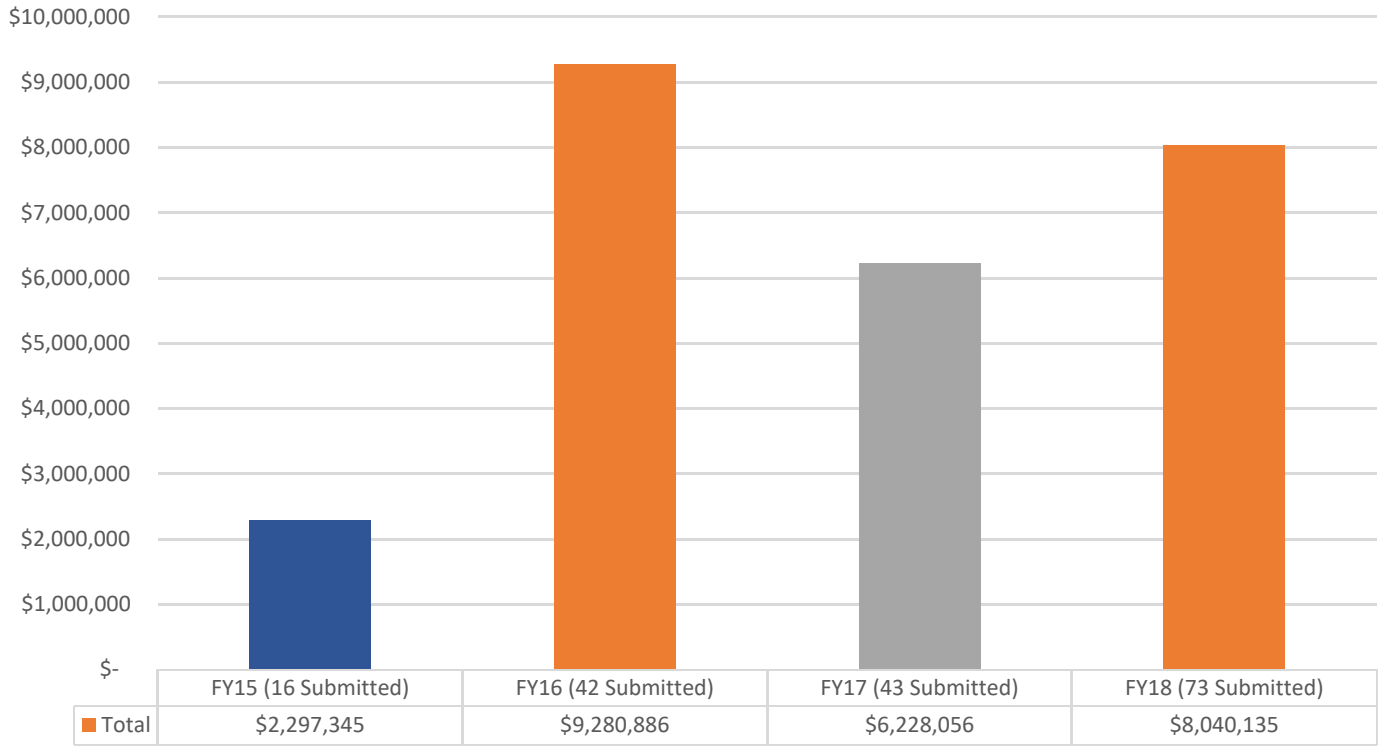

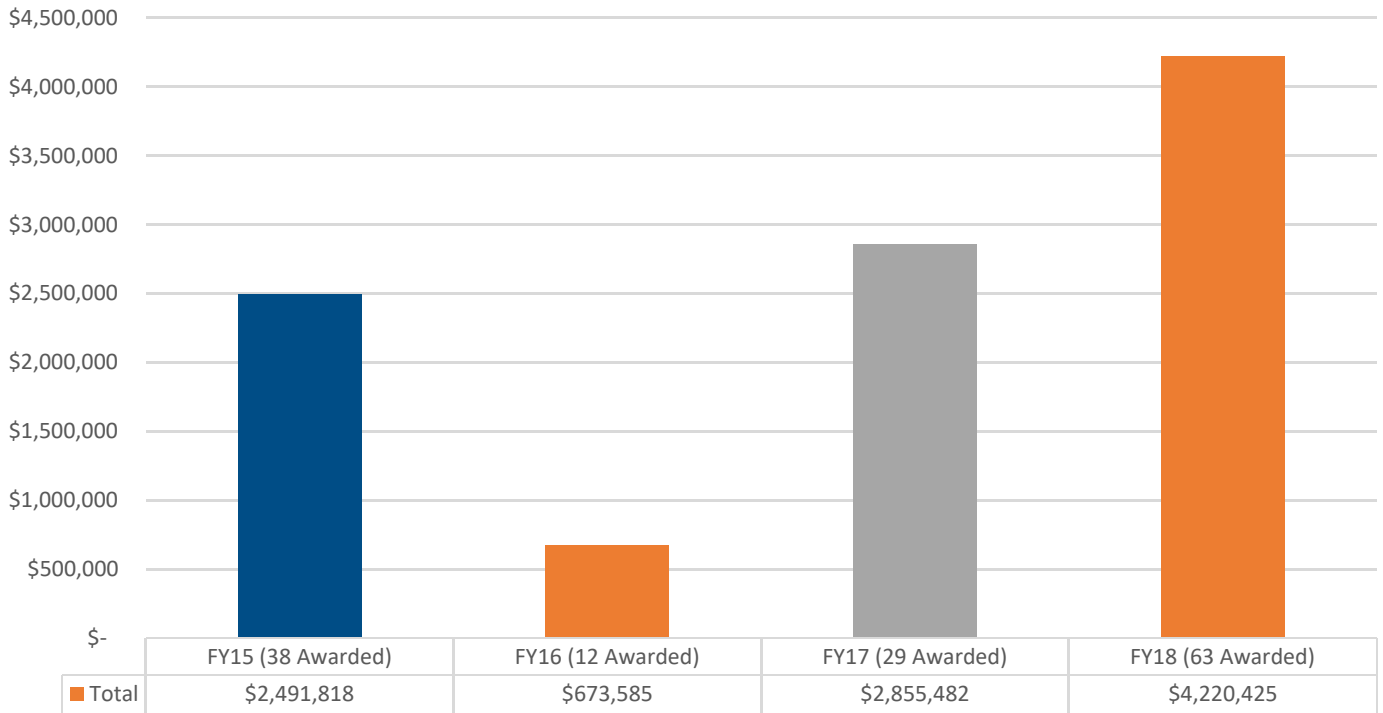

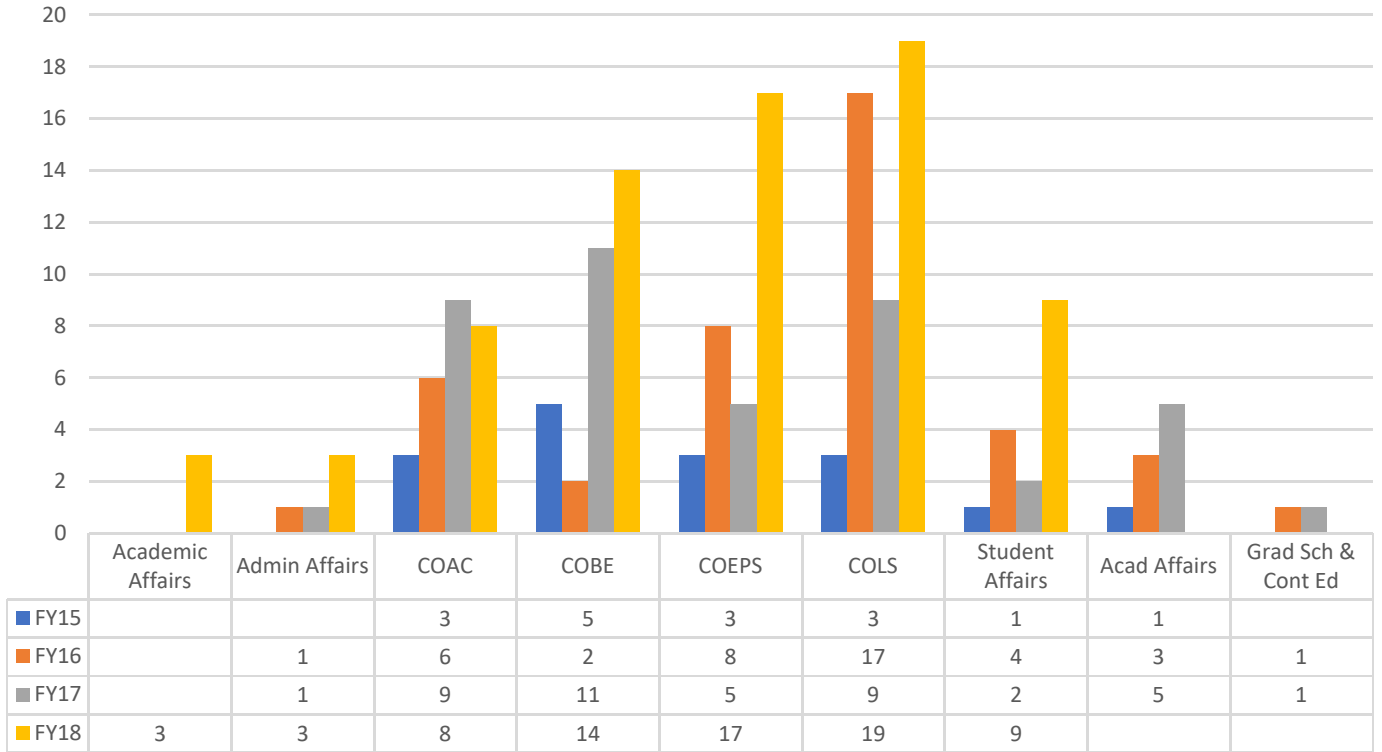
### Dollar Value and Number of Research Proposal Submissions by Fiscal Year



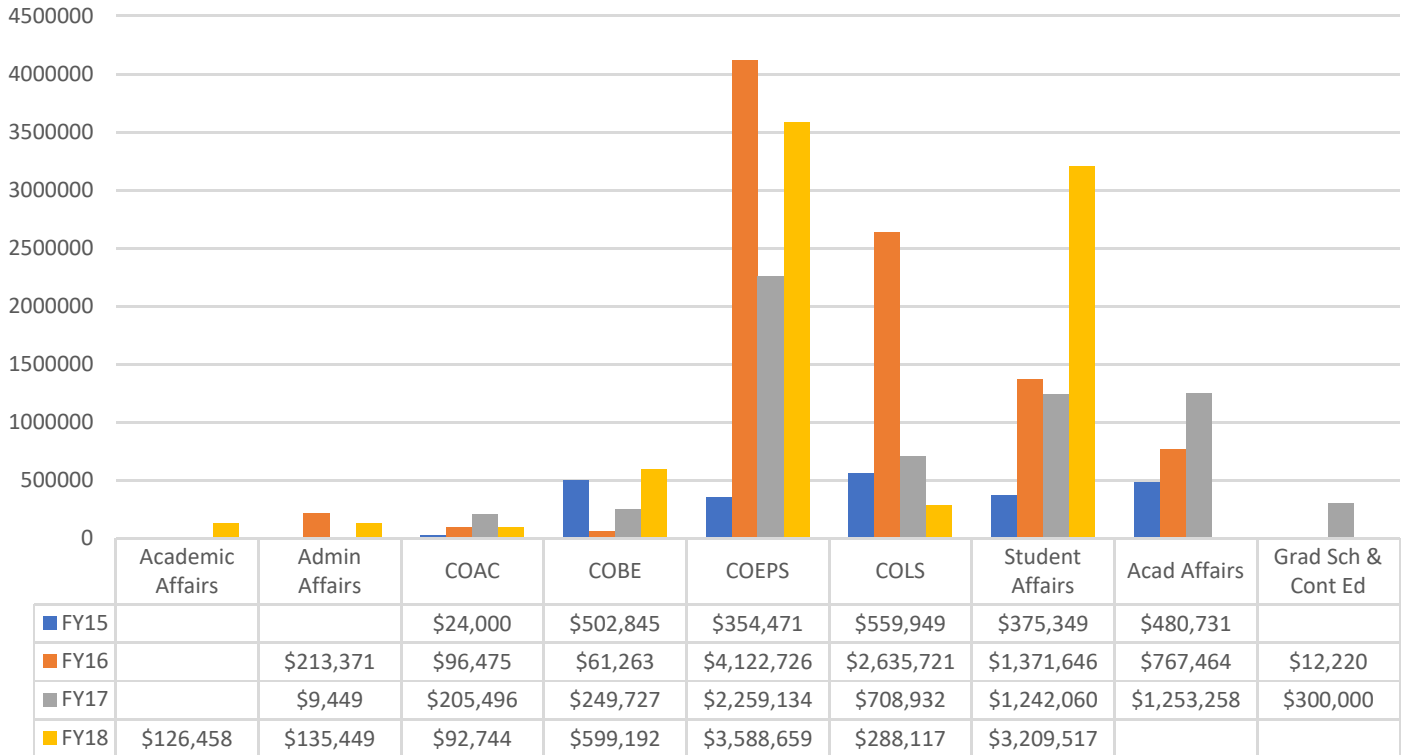
### Dollar Value and Number of Research Awards



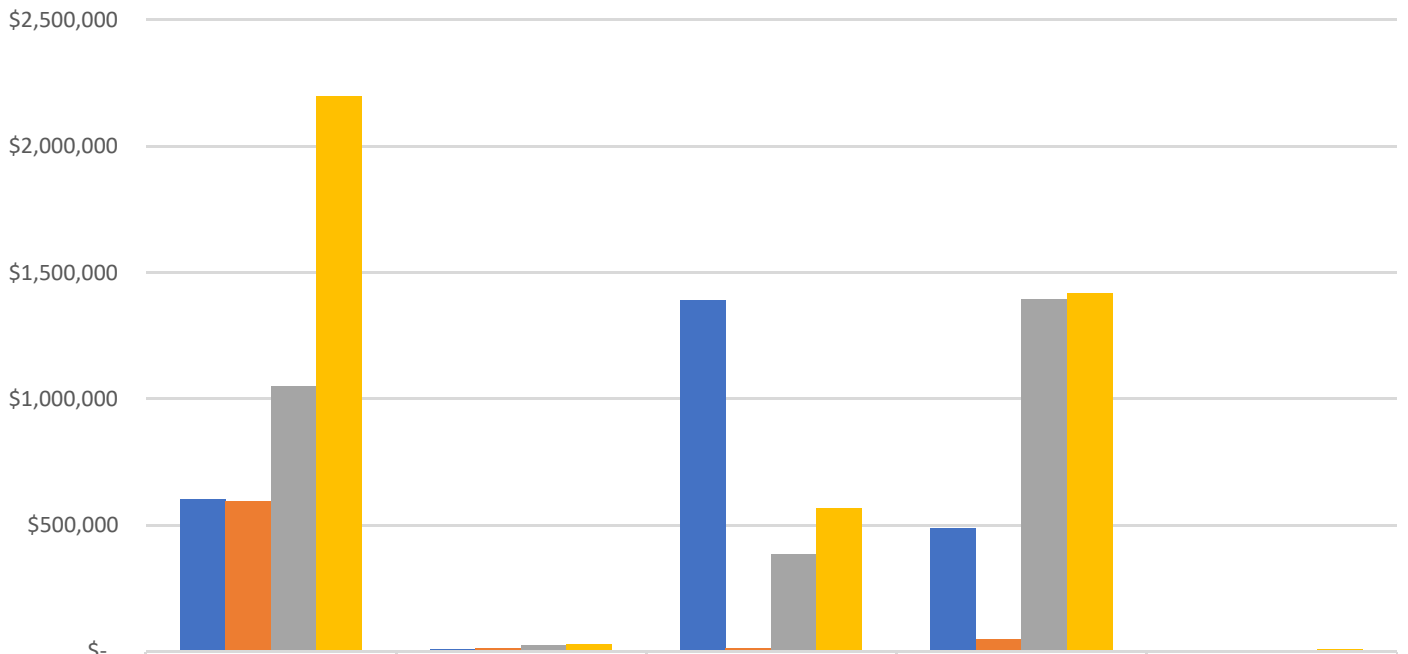
### Number of Proposal Submissions by Division and Fiscal Year



### Dollar Value of Submissions by Division and Year

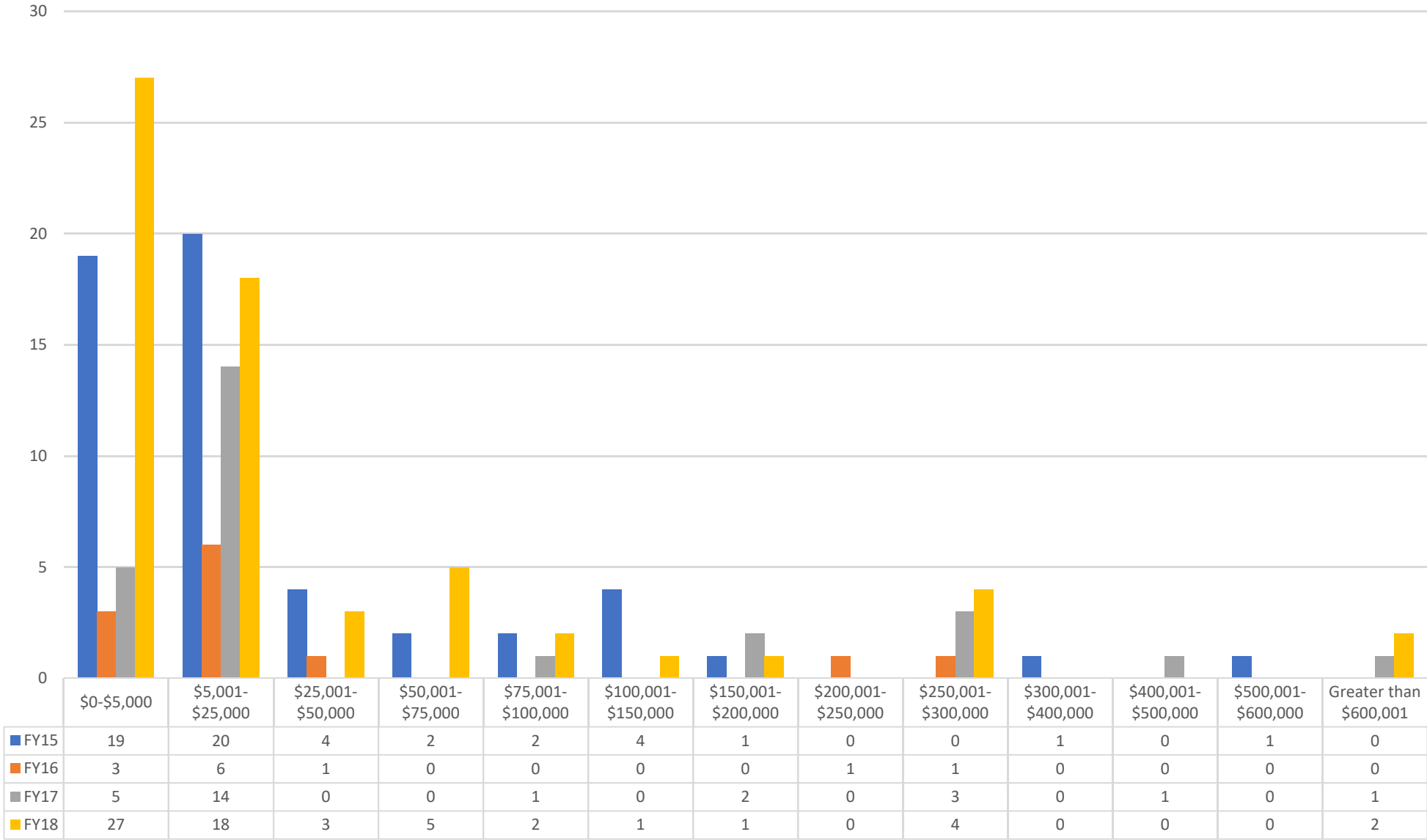

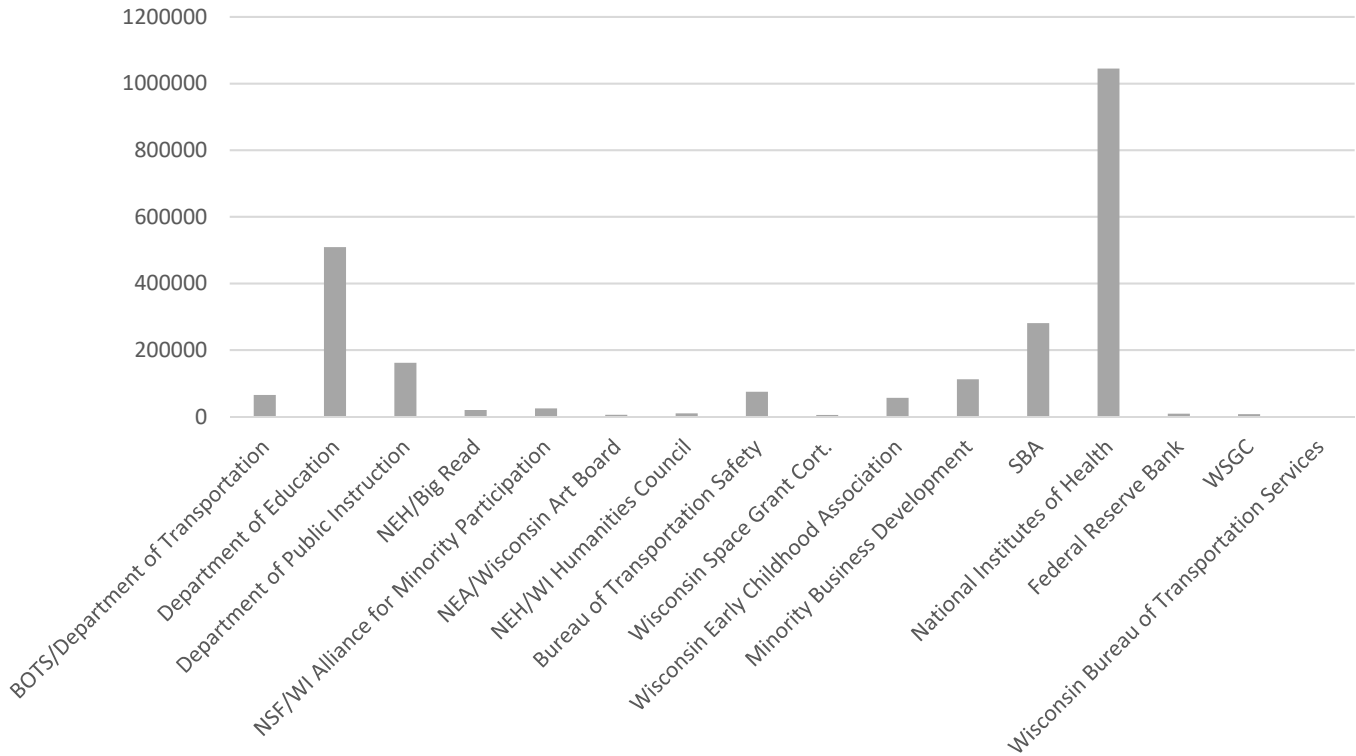

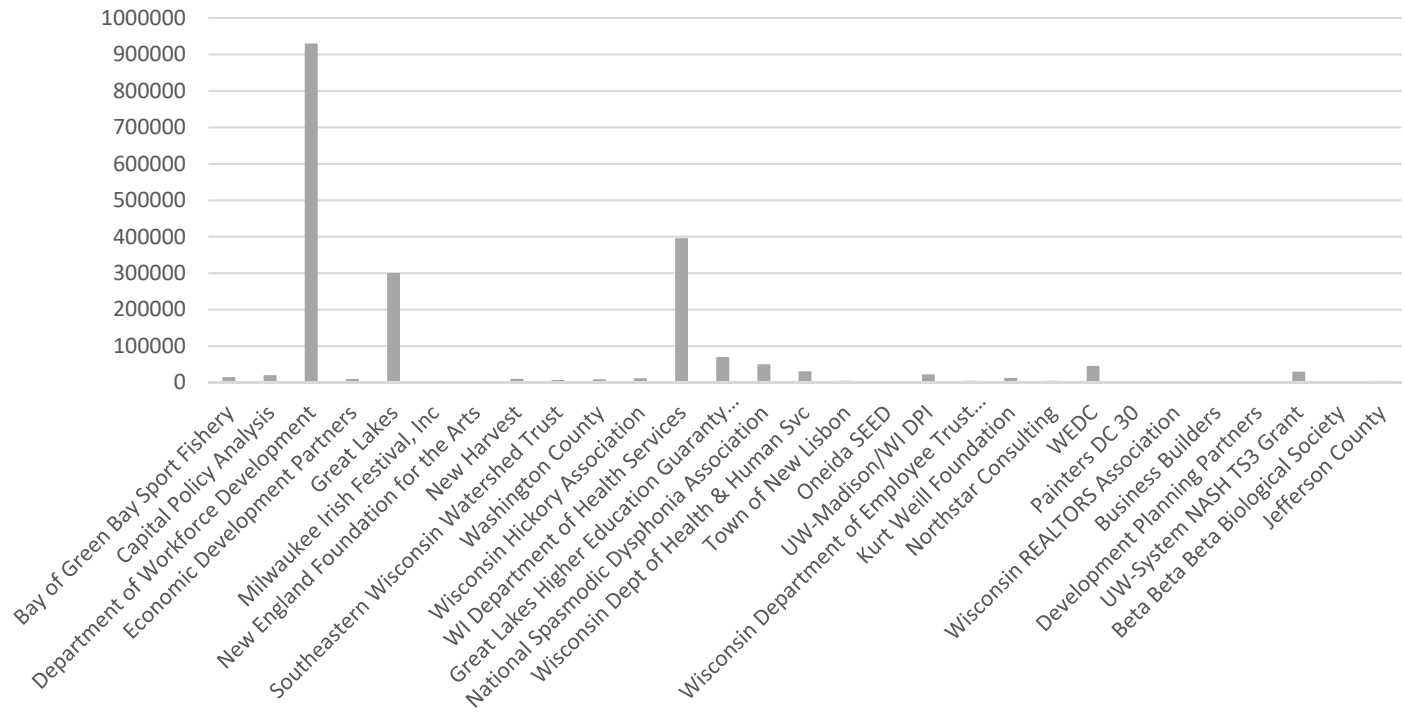
### Number of Awards Broken down by Amount & Fiscal Year

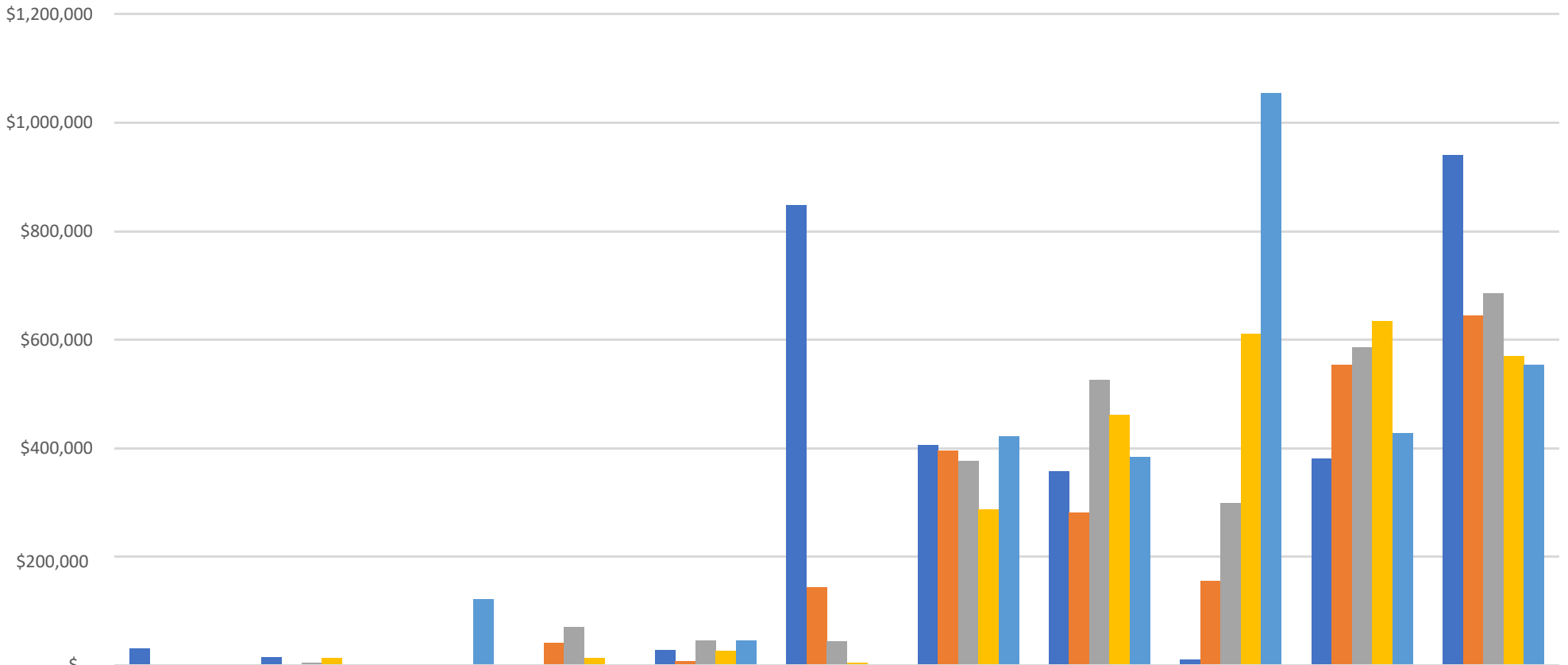

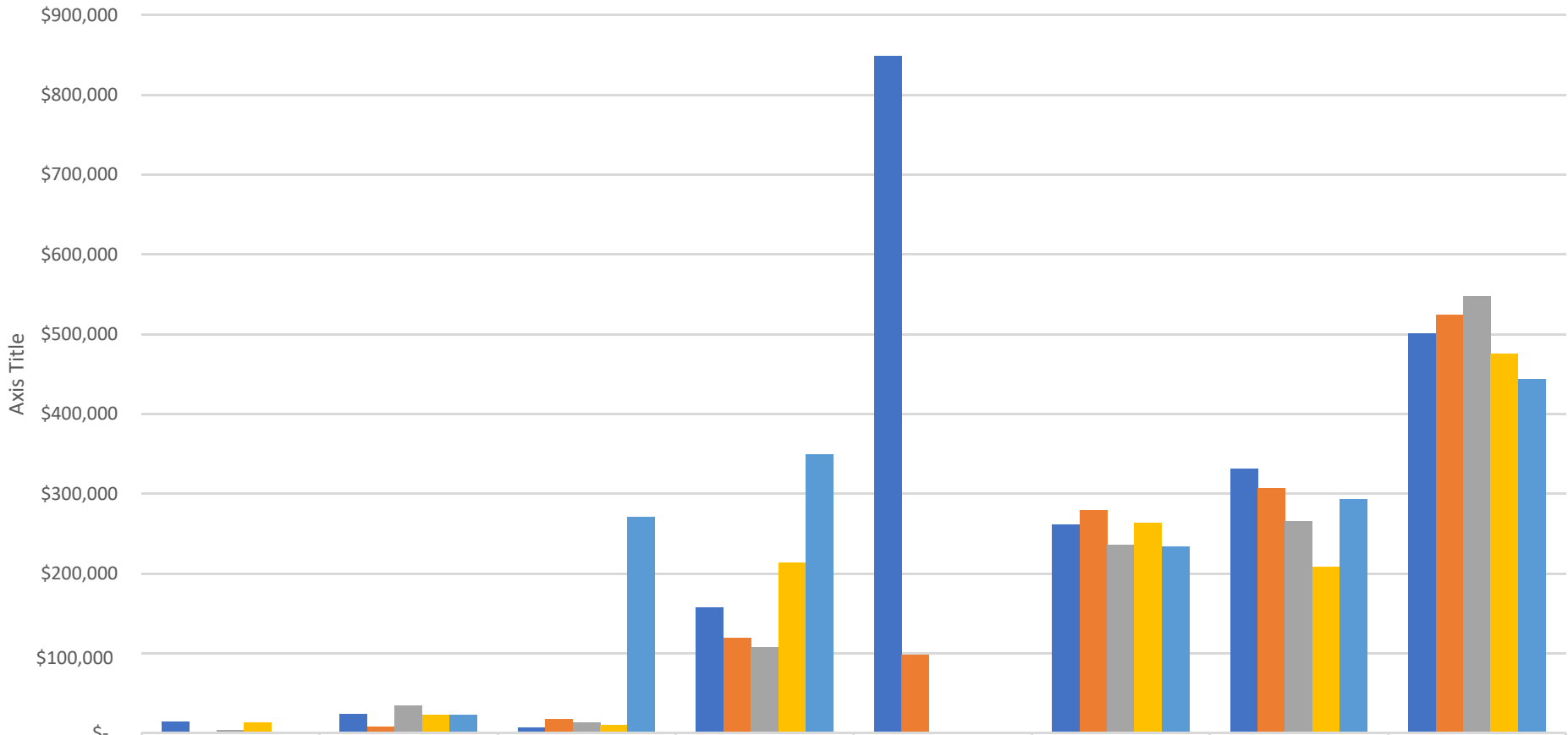


### Total Research Expenditures by Division



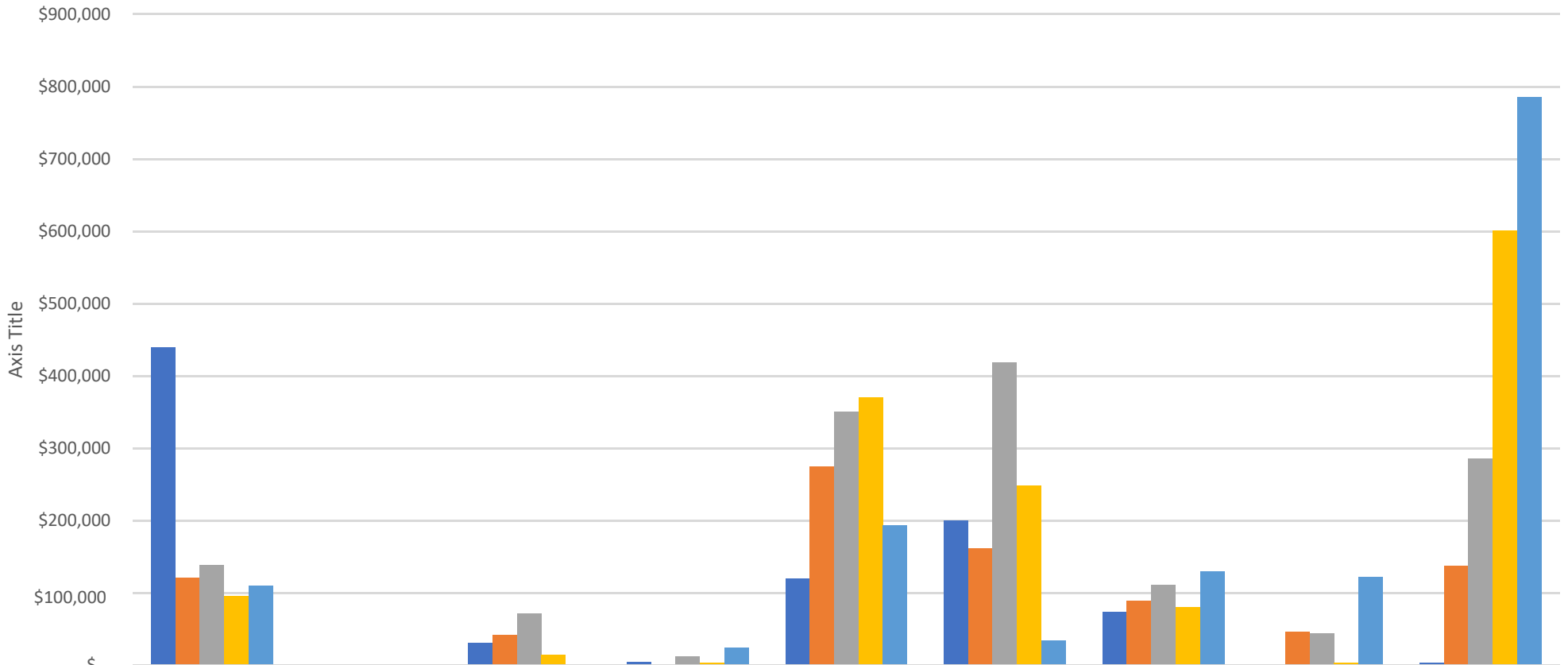

### Total Federal Research Expenditures by Division



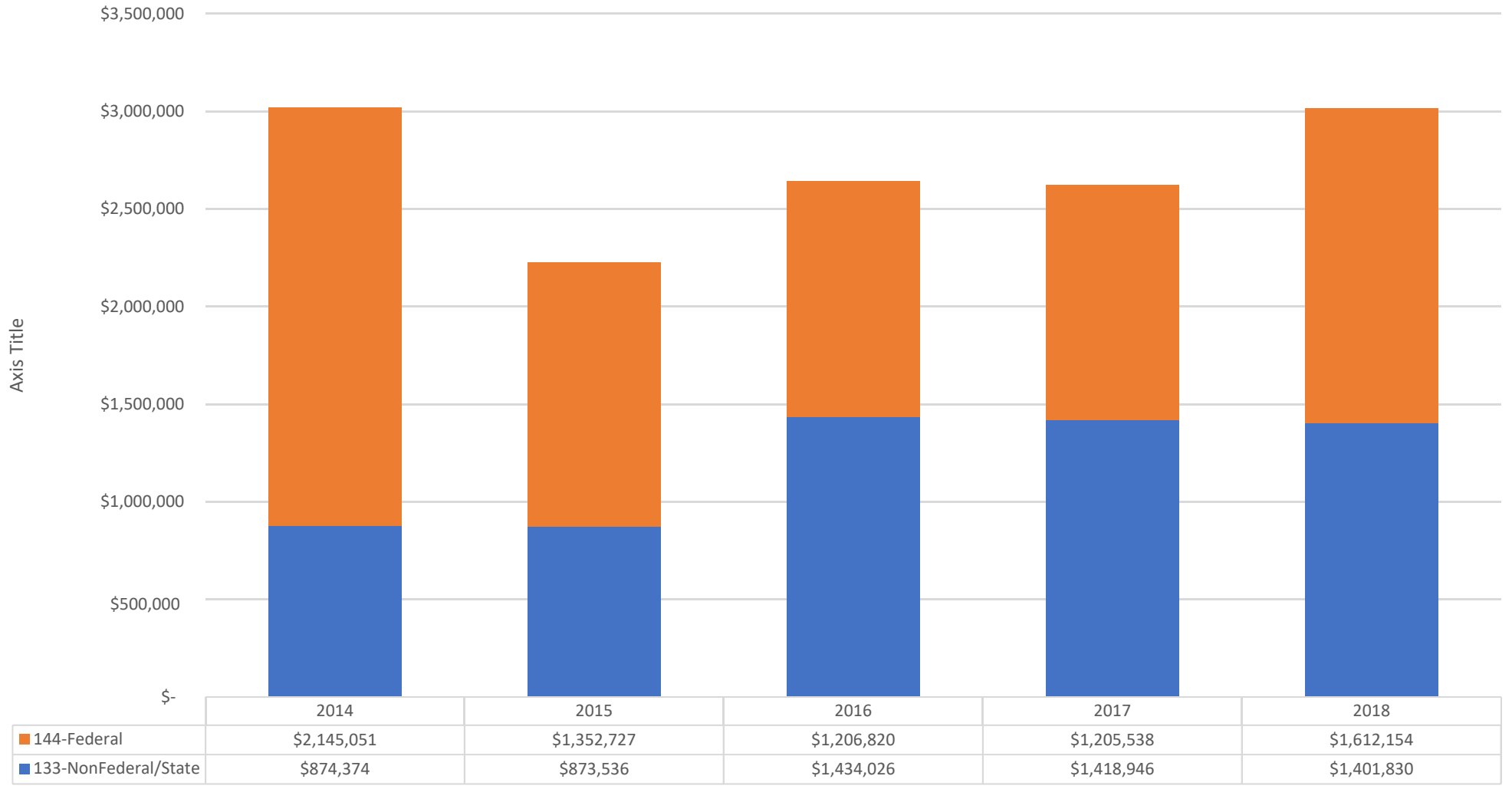
