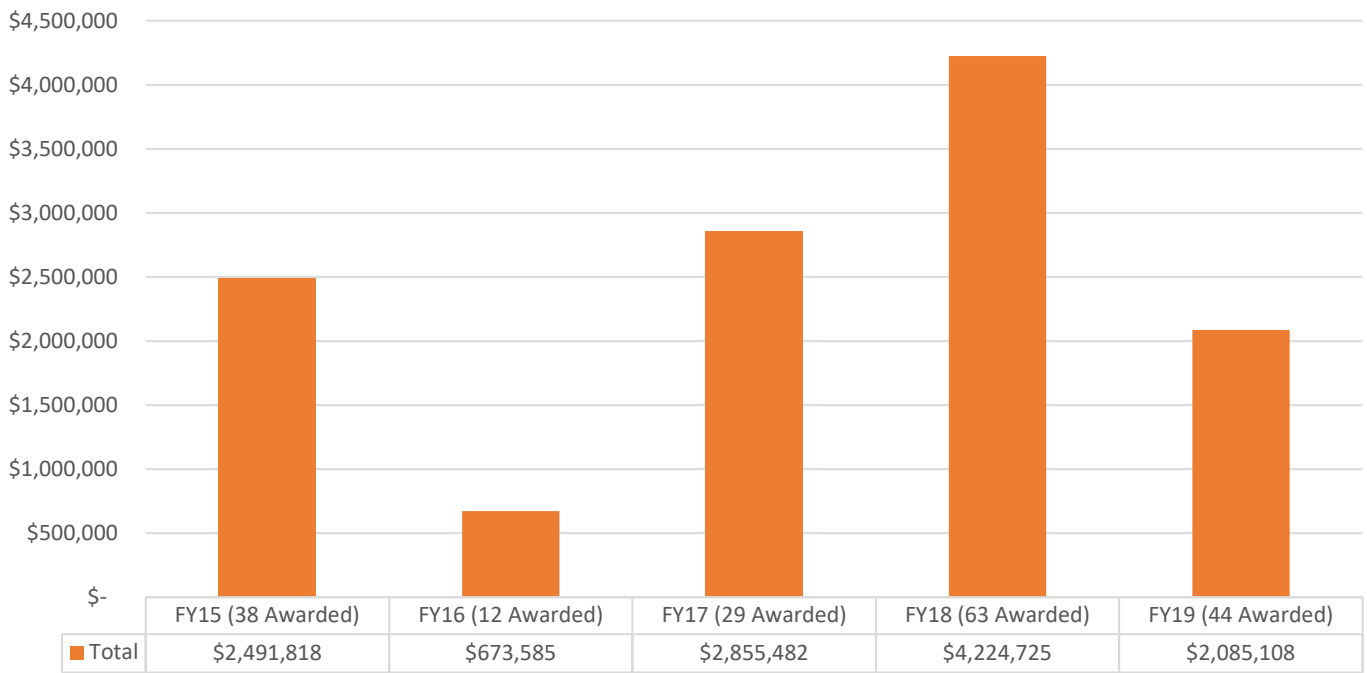

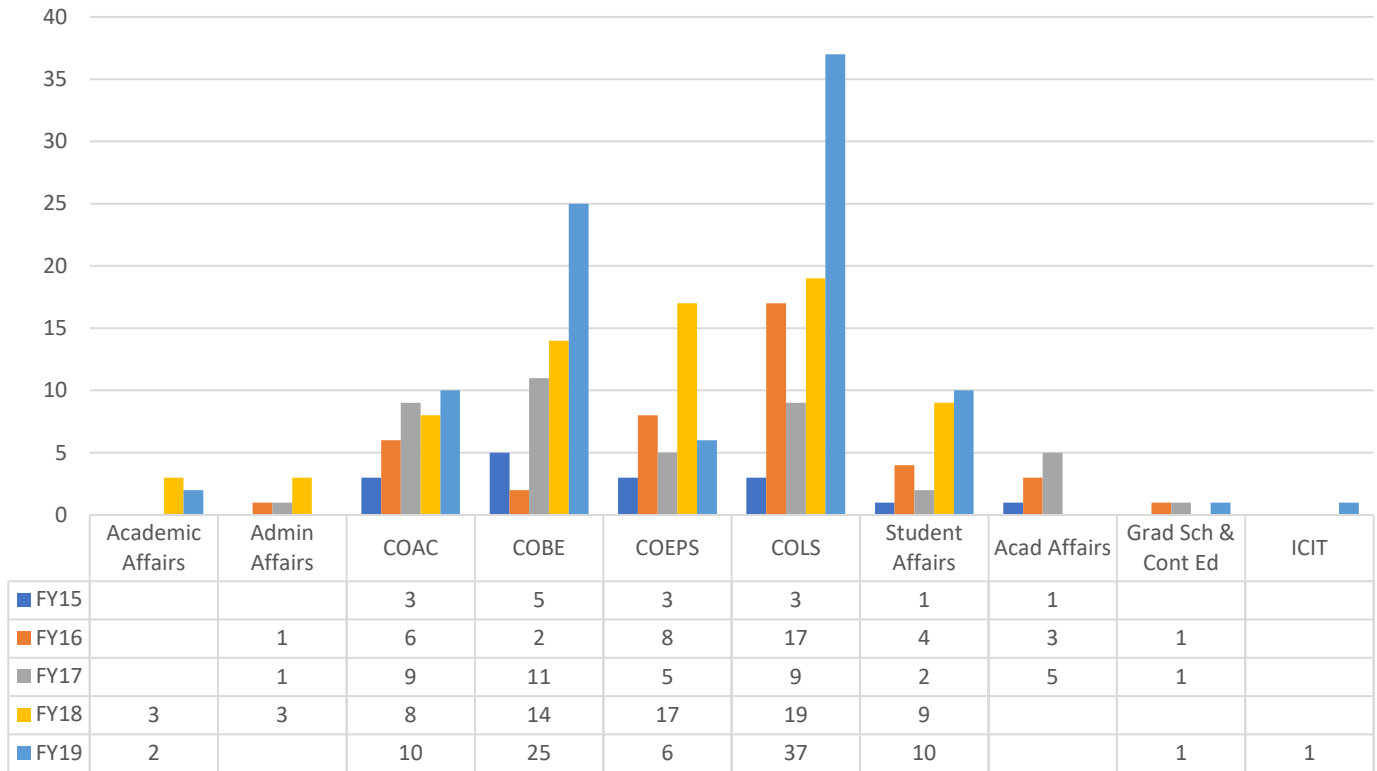
Dollar Value and Number of Research Proposal Submissions by Fiscal Year



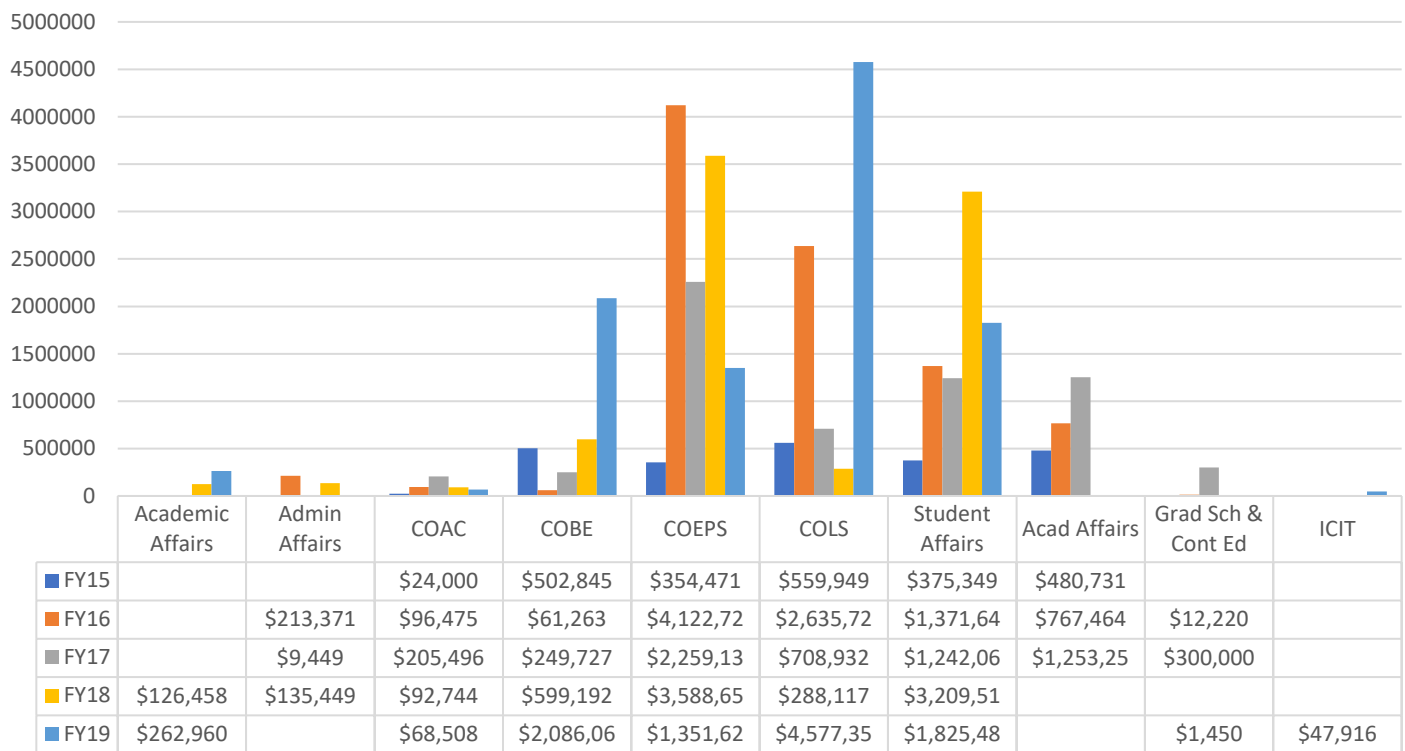
Dollar Value and Number of Research Awards



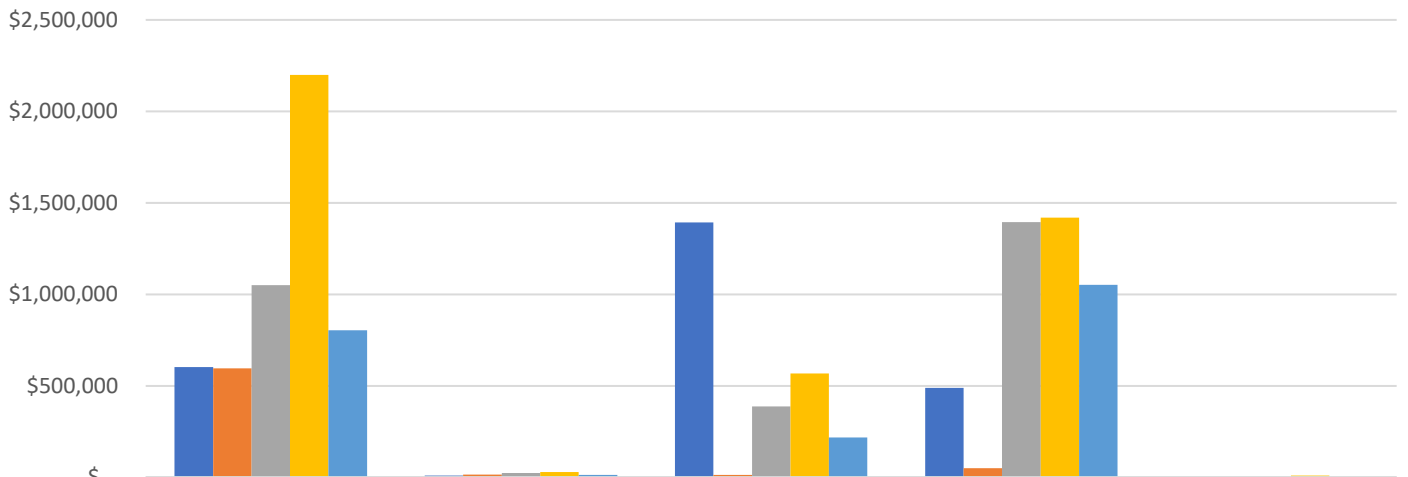
Number of Proposal Submissions by Division and Fiscal Year



Dollar Value of Submissions by Division and Year

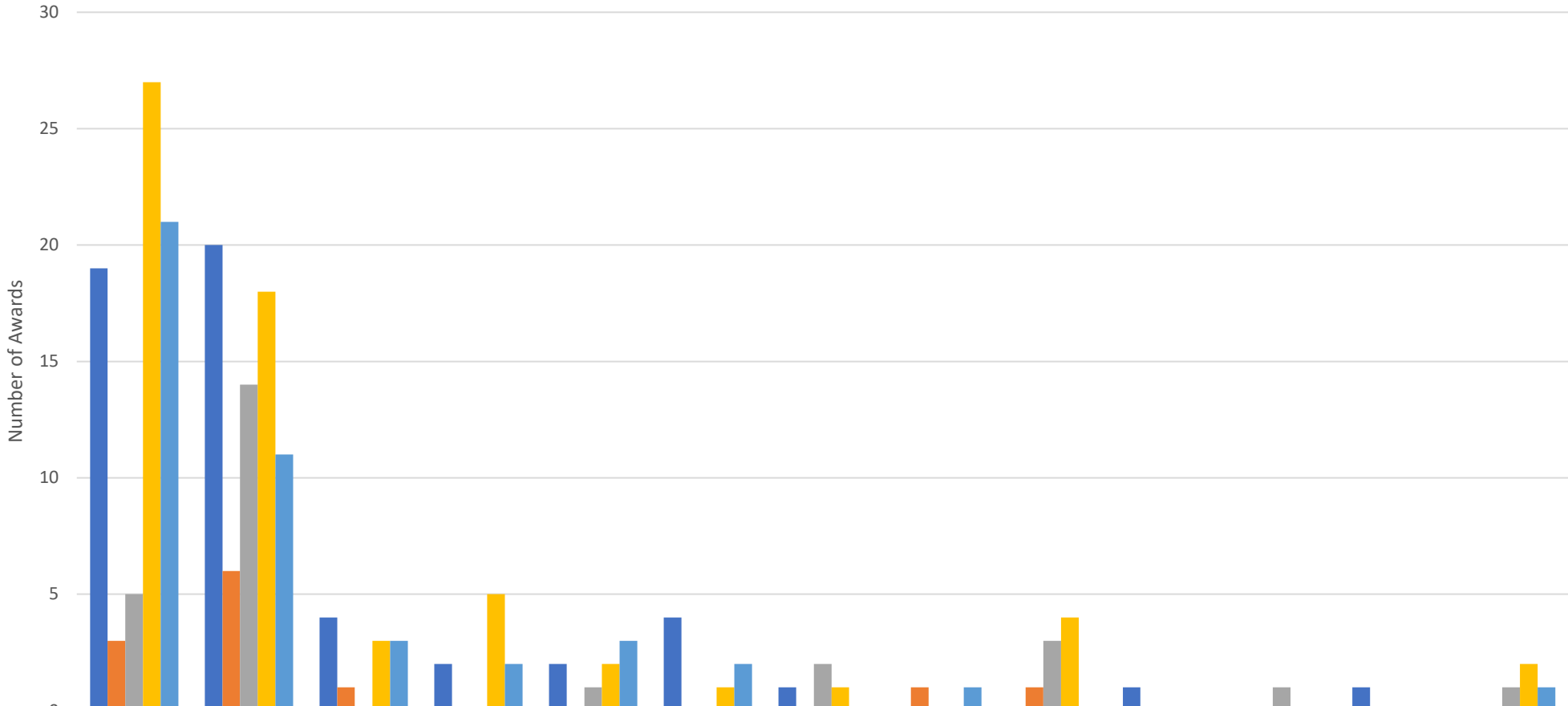


Research Award Value by Funding Type



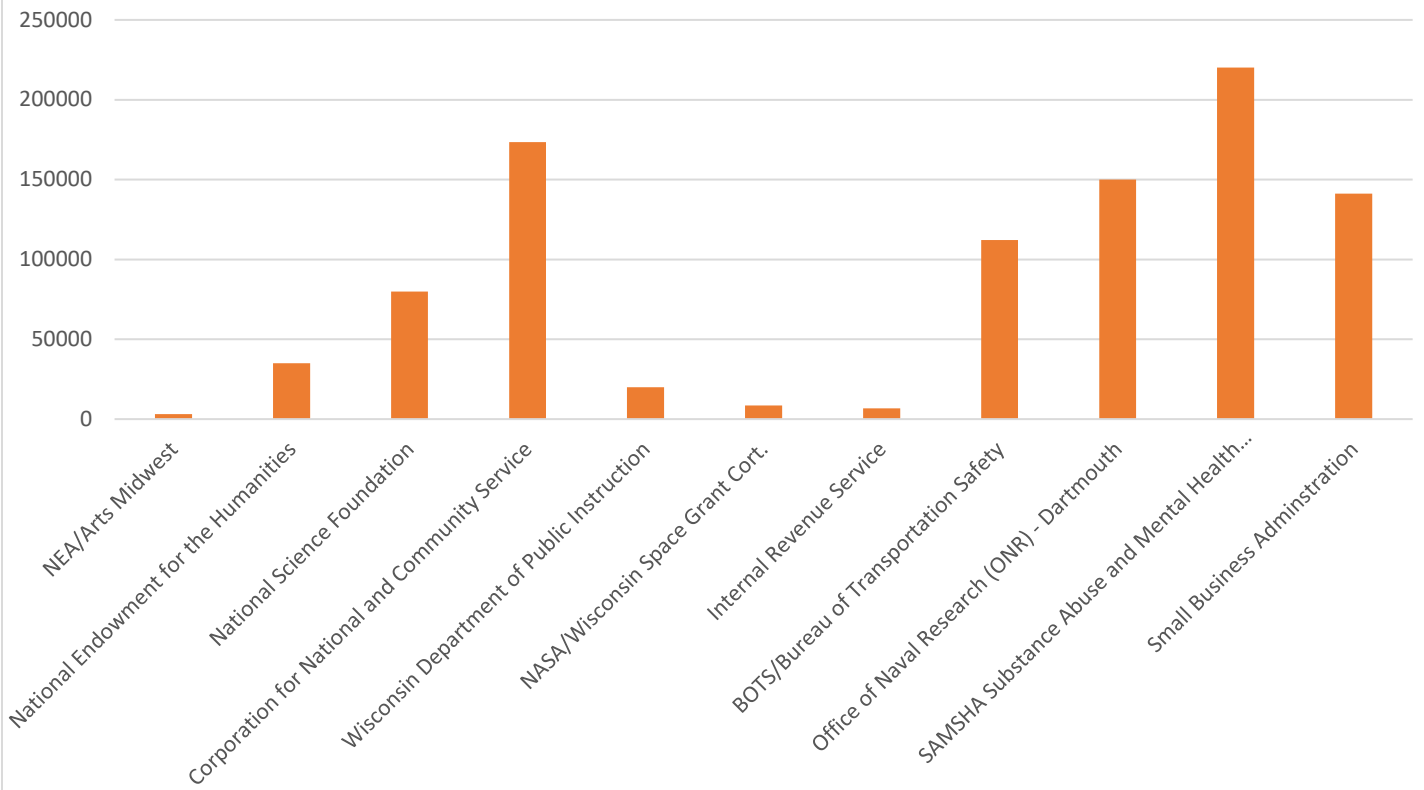

Number of Awards Broken Down by Amount & Fiscal Year

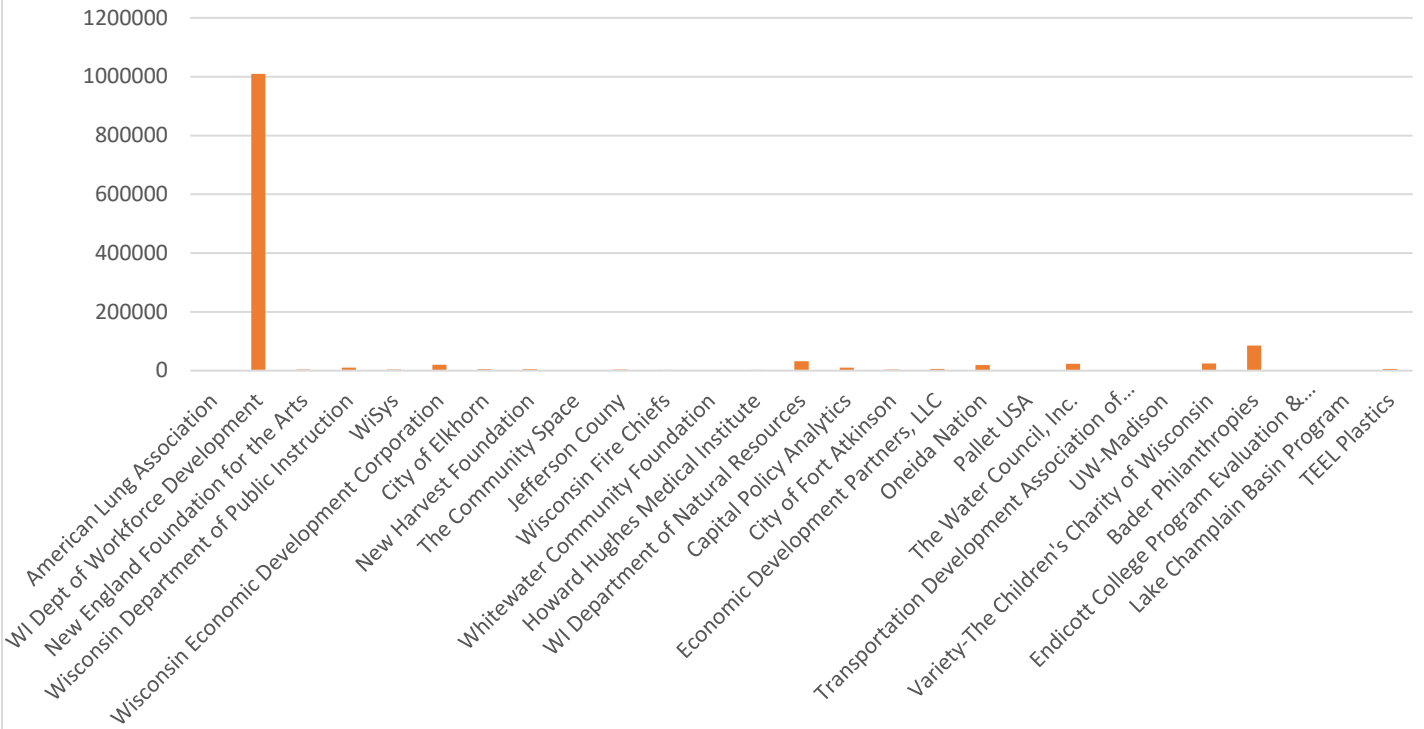

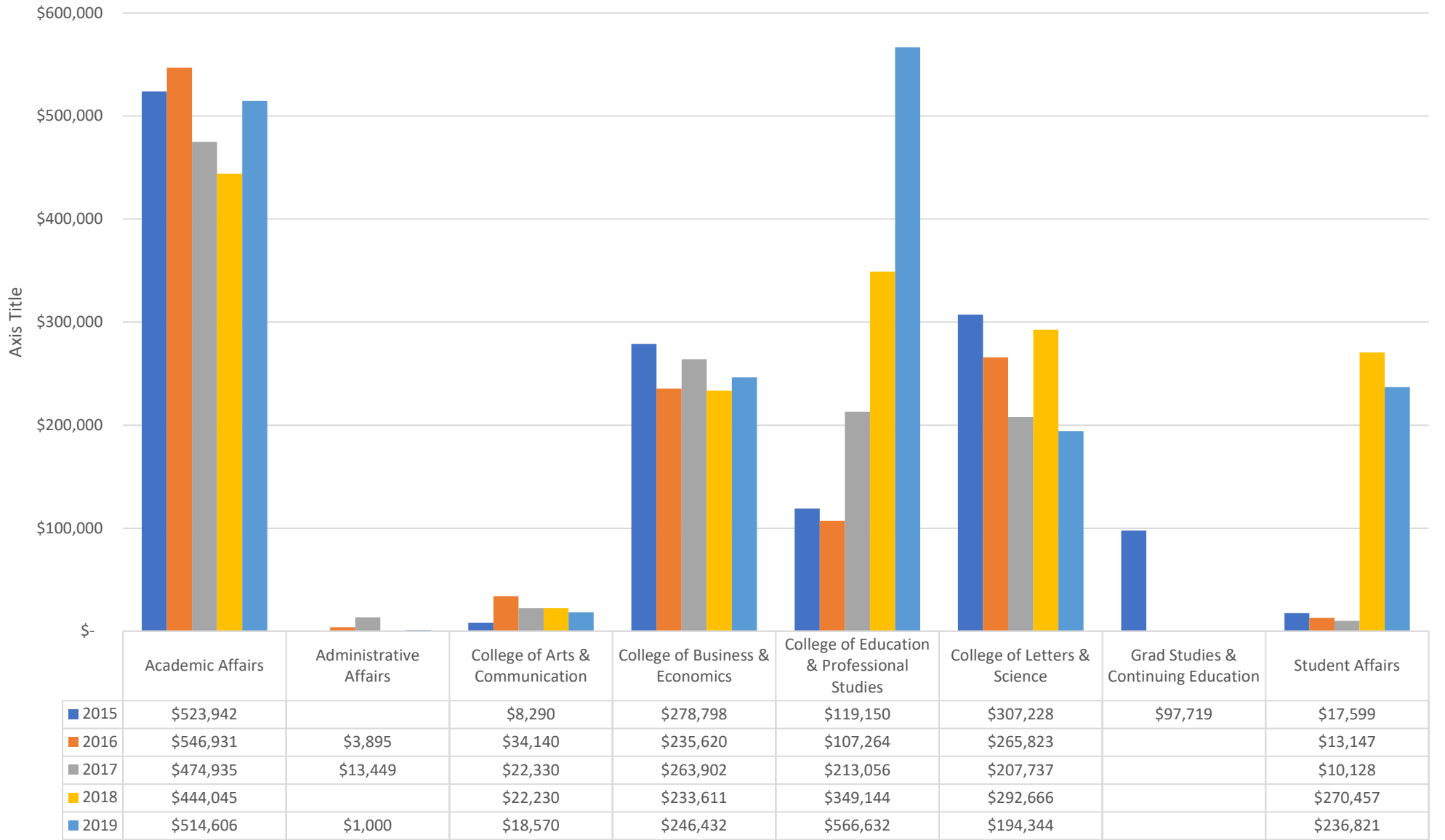

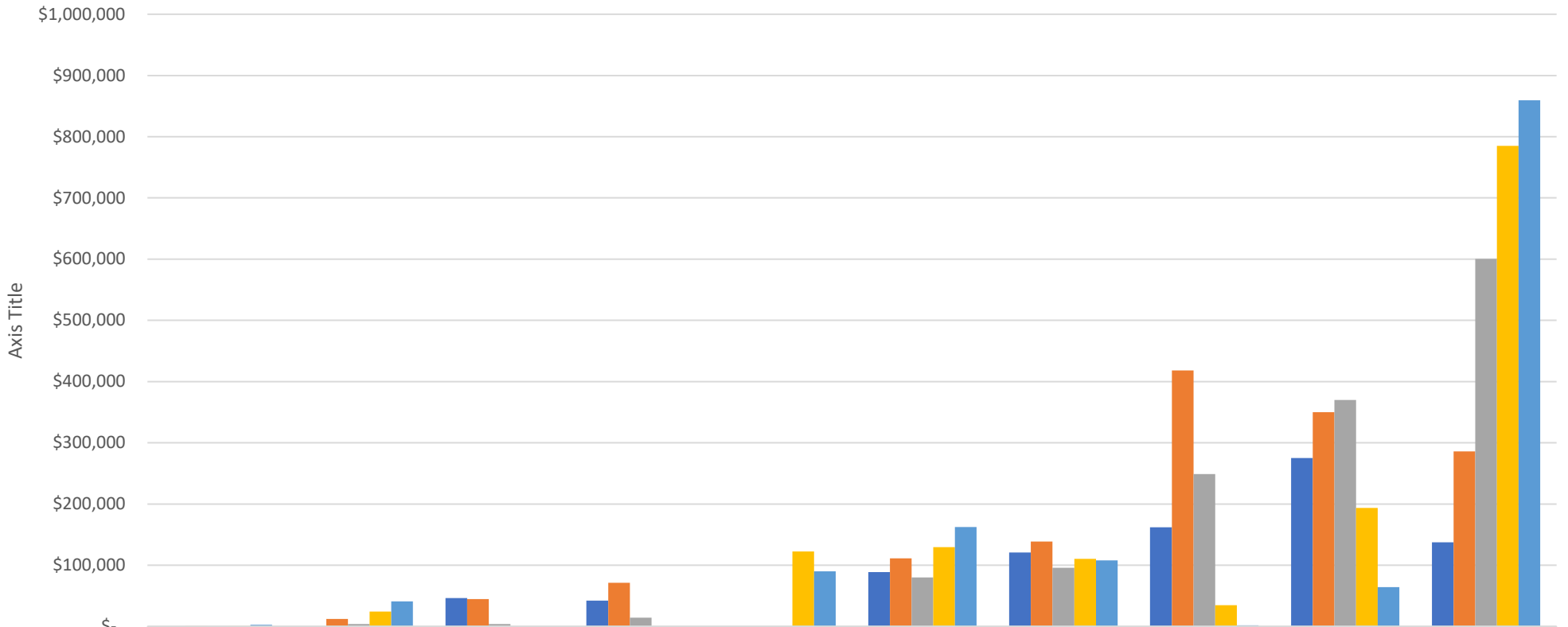

Total Federal Research Expenditures by Division

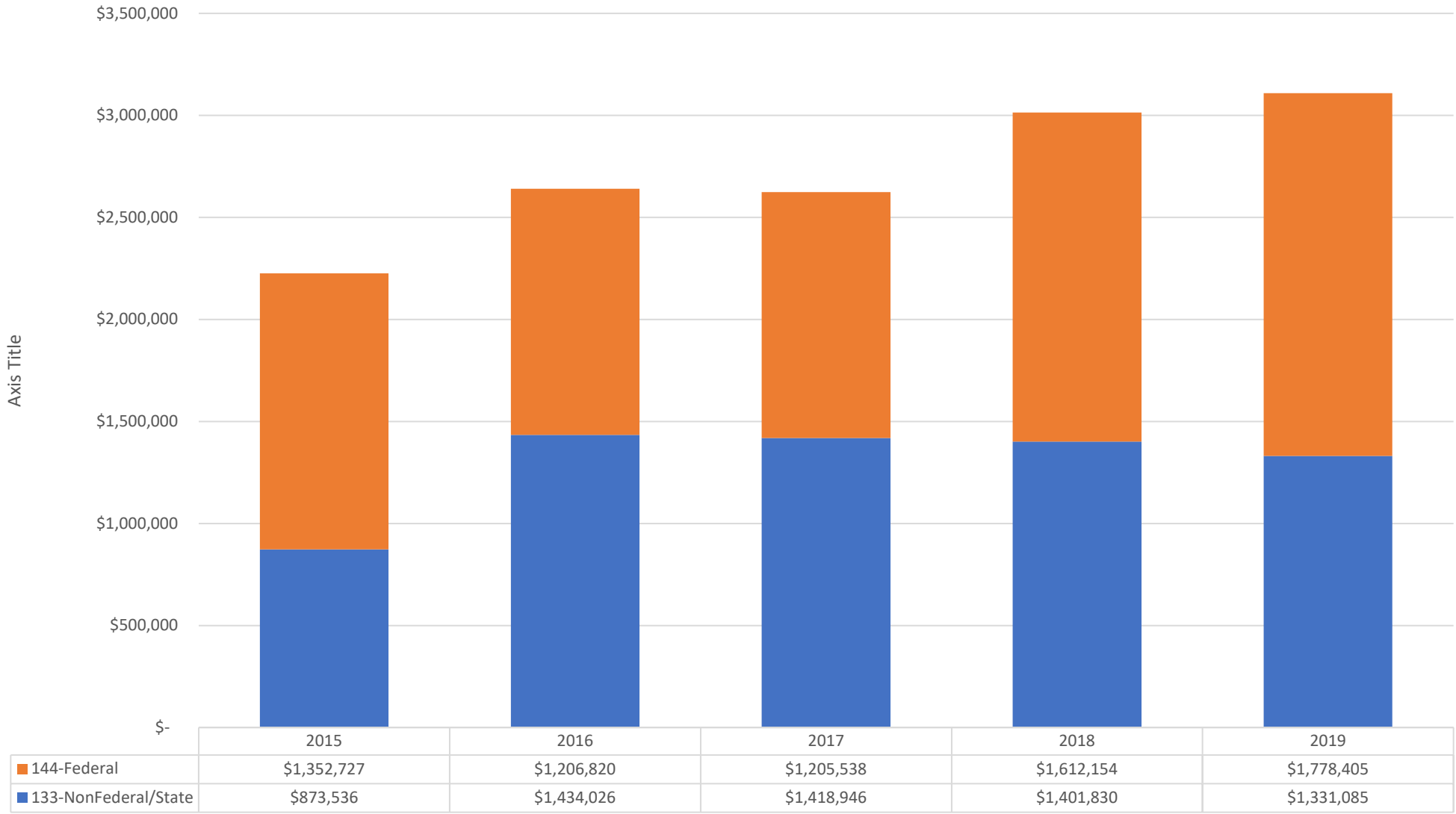


Total Non-Federal Expenditures by Division

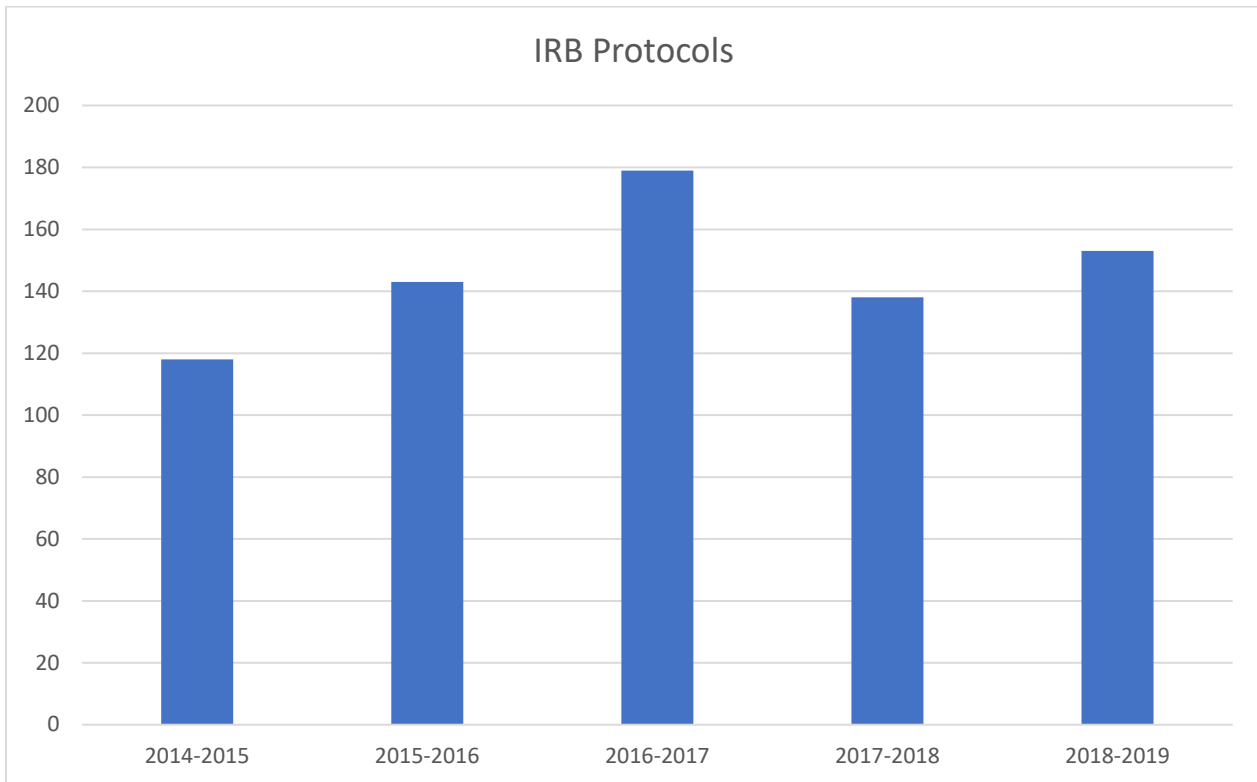
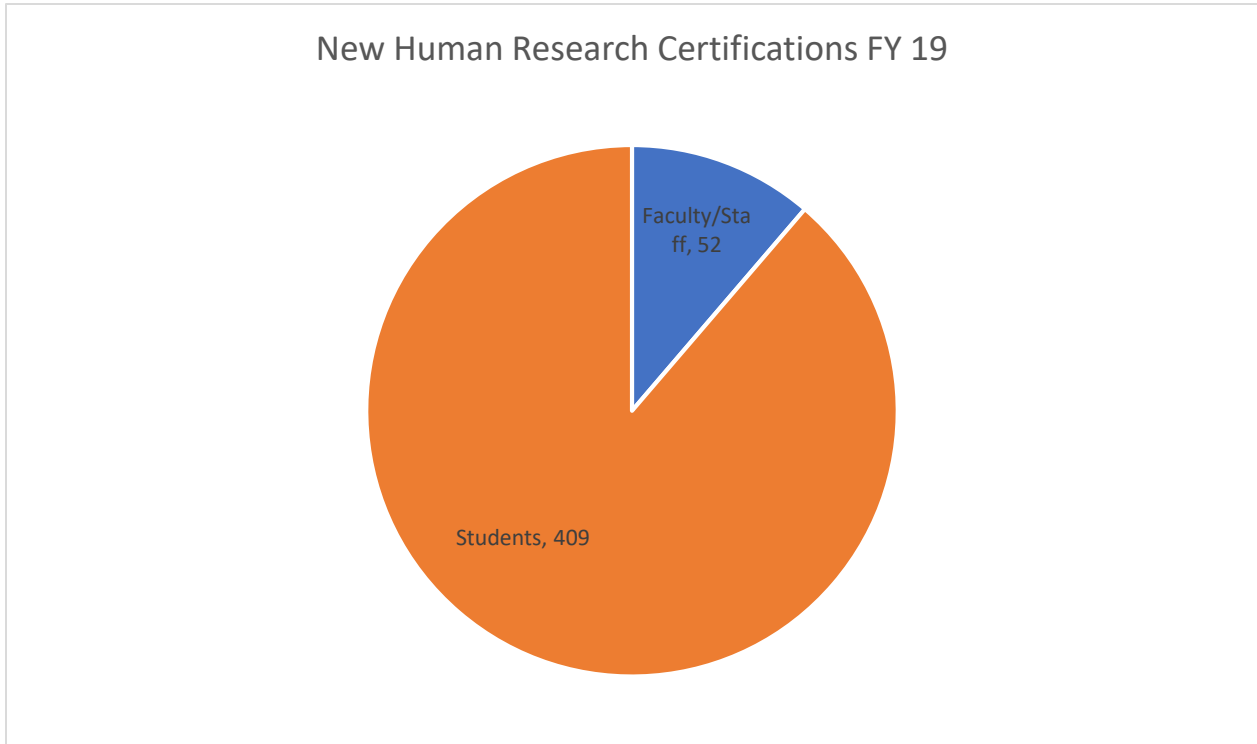

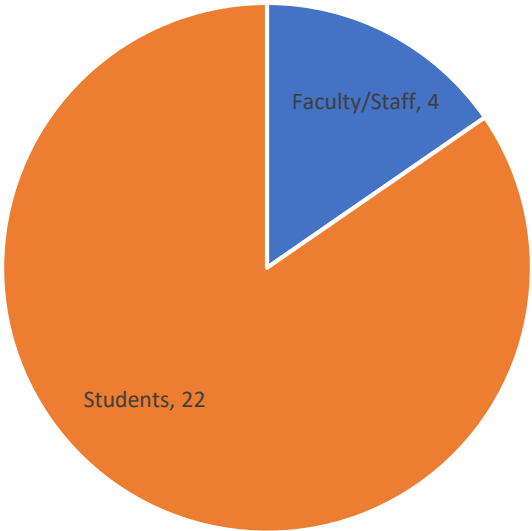
