UW-Eau Claire Transfer Checklist

Application Process:

Spring Deadline: November 1 Fall Deadline: March 1

□ Submit the UW System application at https://apply.wisconsin.edu

- □ Submit official high school transcripts.
- □ Submit official ACT or SAT scores, required for students who have fewer than 18 transferable credits.
- *** You are exempt from this requirement if you are 22 or older.
- $\hfill\square$ Submit official transcripts from each college or university you have attended.

□ If you want to earn your Associate of Arts & Science degree before transferring, please confirm your progress with your Academic Adviser

 \Box Once you have met with your Academic Adviser and know that you are eligible to earn your degree, apply for graduation through your WINS account. Log into WINS, click Academics \rightarrow Graduation, and follow prompts for AAS.

Admission Criteria:

- If you have completed a year of coursework (approximately 30 transferable credits) you will be considered for admission based on a review of your college records. Most admitted students have a GPA of 2.0 or greater.
- If you have fewer than 30 transferable credits you may be considered for admission based on a review of high school and college records.

• Some majors may require a GPA higher than 2.0 for admission into the university, and you must meet or exceed the GPA for your intended major. Current majors with higher GPA are:

Health Care Administration (2.75) Kinesiology (2.75)	Secondary Education (2.5) Social Work (2.5)
