## UW-Eau Claire Transfer Checklist

### Application Process:

Spring Deadline: November 1

Fall Deadline: March 1

- Submit the UW System application at <https://apply.wisconsin.edu>
- Submit official high school transcripts.
- Submit official ACT or SAT scores, required for students who have fewer than 18 transferable credits.  
\*\*\* You are exempt from this requirement if you are 22 or older.
- Submit official transcripts from each college or university you have attended.

- If you want to earn your Associate of Arts & Science degree before transferring, please confirm your progress with your Academic Adviser
- Once you have met with your Academic Adviser and know that you are eligible to earn your degree, apply for graduation through your WINS account. Log into WINS, click Academics→Graduation, and follow prompts for AAS.

### Admission Criteria:

- If you have completed a year of coursework (approximately 30 transferable credits) you will be considered for admission based on a review of your college records. Most admitted students have a GPA of 2.0 or greater.
- If you have fewer than 30 transferable credits you may be considered for admission based on a review of high school and college records.



- Some majors may require a GPA higher than 2.0 for admission into the university, and you must meet or exceed the GPA for your intended major. Current majors with higher GPA are:

Elementary Education (2.5)	Pre-Athletic Training (2.75)
Exercise Science (2.5)	Rehabilitation Science (2.75)
Health Care Administration (2.75)	Secondary Education (2.5)
Kinesiology (2.75)	Social Work (2.5)
Nursing (3.0)	Special Education (2.5)
