Admission Criteria:

- Transfer students must have a 2.0 or higher overall GPA from previous institutions, and be in good academic standing, to be considered for admission. Applicants are given a comprehensive review.
- Transfer students who have fewer than 12 credits completed at the time of application must also meet the freshmen admission guidelines found at https://uwplatt.edu/freshman
