



UW-Whitewater Transfer Checklist

Application Process: (for current UW-Whitewater at Rock County students)

Fall Deadline: May 1 (applications after this date will be reviewed on a case by case basis).

**Students interested in fall enrollment must have applied by May 1. However, to be eligible for academic scholarships, students must have a completed application by February 1.

Spring Deadline: December 20 (applications after this date will be reviewed on a case by case basis)

- Complete the “**Change of Campus**” form found on the Registrar’s website (under Forms) https://uwwhitewater.co1.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_OJ0Da8v3SEKPMCZ
- If you want to earn your Associate of Arts & Science degree before transferring, please confirm your progress with your Academic Adviser
- Once you have met with your Academic Adviser and know that you are eligible to earn your degree, apply for graduation through your WINS account. Log into WINS, click Academics→Graduation, and follow prompts for AAS.

Application Process: (if not a current UW-Whitewater at Rock County student)

Spring Deadline: December 20

Fall Deadline: August 1

- Complete the UW System application at <https://apply.wisconsin.edu>
- Submit final high school transcript, GED or HSED
- If military experience, submit copy of DD214 or military SMART transcript (to be awarded credit for military experience)
- Submit official transcripts from each college or university you have attended (all transcripts must come directly from the institution)
- Please do not submit supporting documents until after you have completed an application

Admissions Criteria:

- Certain courses and majors require appropriate prerequisites and cumulative grade point averages higher than 2.00/4.00 scale. If you do not see a specific major below, the necessary GPA to transfer with that intended major is 2.00/4.00 scale.
